5 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. David, we can start
6 here as soon as partner back. Oh, there he is, okay.

7 David, remember we met you yesterday.
8 I'm Detective Miller.

9 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

10 DETECTIVE MILLER: Detective Harper. And we
11 talked to you yesterday over at the county jail.

12 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

13 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. What we'd like to
14 do, as we explained to you yesterday, is go back over
15 some of this and that we talked about yesterday, you
16 know, and then (Untranslatable) if I can find the --
17 remember yesterday we read you those two -- about the
18 two forms that you signed?

19 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

20 DETECTIVE MILLER: If -- if I can find one now
21 (Untranslatable)

22 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Miller?

23 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yes.

24 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: You have phone call,

25 3-1.

1 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

2 (PAUSE IN TAPE)

3 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Okay. Now starts --
4 phone will stop ringing for a few minutes, okay
5 (Untranslatable) okay.

6 Today is --

7 DETECTIVE HARPER: 27th.

8 DETECTIVE MILLER: January 27th, 1993. What
9 time you got, Jim?

10 DETECTIVE HARPER: 10:30.

11 DETECTIVE MILLER: 10:30. We're at Parker
12 Center. 3-21-A, okay.

13 David, your name is David Jones?

14 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

15 DETECTIVE MILLER: What's the number on
16 your -- booking number; can you see it?

17 DAVID JONES: 336256 (Untranslatable) 37.

18 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Okay. That's it.

19 We talked to you yesterday. We want to
20 review a couple of things.

21 First, these are those two forms that we
22 read to you yesterday and you signed?

23 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

24 DETECTIVE MILLER: One is -- I'll read the
25 first one again.

1 It says, "I, David Jones," and then your
2 initials after that, "do hereby give the below listed
3 detectives permission to transport me to a medical
4 facility and have hair, blood, and saliva samples
5 taken from me.

6 I give this permission freely and
7 voluntarily. This detectives did not coerce,
8 threaten, or offer me any special consideration for
9 my cooperation."

10 And then those are your initials again.

11 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

12 DETECTIVE MILLER: Do you remember --

13 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

14 DETECTIVE MILLER: -- us reading that to you?

15 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

16 DETECTIVE MILLER: And then you signing that?

17 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

18 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Here, and the other
19 one says, "I, David Jones," and then your initials.

20 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

21 DETECTIVE MILLER: -- "give permission to the
22 below listed detectives to remove me from the custody
23 of the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department.

24 The purpose of this -- the purpose of
25 the detectives for removing me is so that I can

1 direct them to the location where I murdered that
2 woman.

3 This consent is given to -- by me
4 freely, voluntarily, and without any threats or
5 permission."

6 And that's your initials after that?

7 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

8 DETECTIVE MILLER: Do you remember us reading
9 that to you?

10 Is that a yes?

11 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

12 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. And that's your
13 signature there, David?

14 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

15 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Okay.

16 DAVID JONES: Only thing about it
17 (Untranslatable)

18 DETECTIVE MILLER: Well, we're going to get
19 around to all that in a second.

20 DAVID JONES: Oh.

21 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Remember yesterday
22 we read you your rights. I'm going to do that again.
23 Constitutional rights. That's, you know, cops, we
24 got to go through this stuff.

25 DAVID JONES: Oh, yeah.

1 "I have read -- I have read this to you."

2 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh (Untranslatable) discuss
3 the programs and stuff?

4 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, as I said, I -- let's
5 see here. Mark that out. "You have read to me and I
6 understand the above listed rights" You understand
7 all these rights that I read to you, David?

8 Is that a yes?

9 DAVID JONES: Yes.

10 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. "I do wish to waive
11 my rights as listed above." You want to talk to us
12 about these incidents and cooperate with us?

13 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

14 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. What I need you to
15 do is initial right there where I scratched that out.
16 I put a little X there by number five.

17 DAVID JONES: Right here?

18 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, that's fine, David,
19 okay.

20 Now, do the same thing here where I
21 scratched this out. I put an X there. And put your
22 initials, okay.

23 Now, I need you to sign it right there,
24 David, where it says signature, okay.

25 And put today's date, January -- 1-27 --

1 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
2 DETECTIVE MILLER: -- 93. And put a time
3 right next to it. It's 10:36.
4 DETECTIVE HARPER: A.M.
5 DETECTIVE MILLER: A.M., okay. And I'll sign
6 as a witness, okay. Put that away, okay.
7 What we're going to do is go back over
8 what you explained to us yesterday about how you knew
9 these girls and where you met them, you know, just so
10 that we understand it better.
11 DAVID JONES: Sometime I speak to them. I say
12 hi to them, you know, because I barely see -- with
13 me, I barely come around the neighborhood too much
14 because a lot of happenings go around there, you
15 know, like shooting.
16 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. You --
17 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
18 DETECTIVE MILLER: Whereabouts do you live?
19 DAVID JONES: Huh?
20 DETECTIVE MILLER: Where do you live at?
21 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) San Gabriel.
22 DETECTIVE MILLER: And the address there?
23 DAVID JONES: 234 East 101.
24 DETECTIVE MILLER: 234 East 101, okay. How
25 far is that from the -- that school where you went,

1 the elementary school? Is it 97th Street School?

2 DAVID JONES: From my house to there?

3 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.

4 DAVID JONES: Like five -- 10 minutes.

5 DETECTIVE MILLER: Five or 10 minutes?

6 DAVID JONES: By foot.

7 DETECTIVE MILLER: By foot?

8 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

9 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Did you go to

10 elementary school there?

11 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

12 DETECTIVE MILLER: Oh, so you're quite with

13 it.

14 DAVID JONES: I was a kid in the neighborhood.

15 DETECTIVE MILLER: Right.

16 DAVID JONES: The whole neighborhood.

17 DETECTIVE MILLER: Well, you go over there and

18 play ball and everything else?

19 DAVID JONES: Right, I used to go over and

20 play ball during the daytime.

21 DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.

22 DAVID JONES: Like every now and then all the

23 guys get together sometimes like sometimes at school.

24 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.

25 DAVID JONES: And sometime on the weekend.

1 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So you've lived in
2 the neighborhood for how long?

3 DAVID JONES: Last when I lived in the
4 neighborhood (Untranslatable) like that.

5 DETECTIVE MILLER: So you lived there for a
6 long, long time.

7 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) and we moved
8 from there (Untranslatable) my mother had moved from
9 there when I was in jail (Untranslatable) time.

10 DETECTIVE MILLER: Right.

11 DAVID JONES: I was younger.

12 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

13 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

14 DETECTIVE MILLER: So you've lived there most
15 of your adult life, most of your life.

16 DAVID JONES: Well, most of my young life.

17 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.

18 DAVID JONES: Okay. And I got out when I was
19 18.

20 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

21 DAVID JONES: And during the years and stuff,
22 you know.

23 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

24 DAVID JONES: I started hanging around
25 (Untranslatable) that's (Untranslatable)

1 DETECTIVE MILLER: Pictures (Untranslatable)
2 DETECTIVE HARPER: (Untranslatable)
3 DETECTIVE MILLER: No, the -- no, the --
4 DETECTIVE HARPER: The workbook?
5 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, the workbook. I
6 think it's on my desk (Untranslatable)
7 DAVID JONES: And see, like something like the
8 guys do, you know, like some will go down with them,
9 you know, blame me for something.
10 DETECTIVE MILLER: (Untranslatable)
11 DAVID JONES: And something like that.
12 DETECTIVE MILLER: Well, what we're going to
13 do is just go back and, you know, we can compare what
14 happened --
15 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
16 DETECTIVE MILLER: (Untranslatable) don't
17 involved you.
18 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
19 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, just (Untranslatable)
20 you know.
21 DAVID JONES: Because if I didn't do it --
22 DETECTIVE MILLER: That's -- I told you
23 yesterday we're trying to eliminate you.
24 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) yeah.
25 DETECTIVE MILLER: Just the same as we try

1 and, you know, make somebody the suspect, we also
2 have the duty of trying to eliminate them as a
3 suspect.

4 DAVID JONES: Oh.

5 DETECTIVE MILLER: Right?

6 DAVID JONES: Oh, okay (Untranslatable) I
7 don't -- I don't hurt nobody, you know, because if I
8 get high I might flake out (Untranslatable)

9 DETECTIVE MILLER: Sure.

10 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

11 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.

12 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) I might -- I
13 might talk stuff, you know, because somebody
14 (Untranslatable) beat me up, I be (Untranslatable)
15 because a lot of times my brother see me like that.

16 DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.

17 DAVID JONES: You know, they (Untranslatable)

18 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay (Untranslatable)
19 yesterday we showed you this picture and you said you
20 remembered this girl. Remember --

21 DAVID JONES: Oh, yeah, because a lot of times
22 my brother talks to her. I -- I --

23 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. You -- you know what
24 her name was?

25 DAVID JONES: Huh-uh, I never knew her.

1 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. But you -- but
2 you -- you've seen her.

3 DAVID JONES: I've seen her around.

4 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, okay.

5 DAVID JONES: Because my brother -- my brother
6 had known her real well.

7 DETECTIVE MILLER: That's [REDACTED], okay.
8 Remember yesterday you told us that you dated her,
9 took her over to the school. You guys smoked dope,
10 crack.

11 DAVID JONES: Yeah, that's it.

12 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. What -- okay. Well,
13 yeah, I know, David. Where'd you meet her at that
14 night?

15 DAVID JONES: Uh.

16 DETECTIVE MILLER: Do you remember when it
17 was?

18 DAVID JONES: I was kind of --

19 DETECTIVE MILLER: How long ago?

20 DAVID JONES: That was because I was toasted,
21 you know --

22 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.

23 DAVID JONES: -- myself.

24 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Toasted. You mean
25 you were -- have drinks, a little coke?

1 DAVID JONES: No, I was drinking most --
2 mostly.

3 DETECTIVE MILLER: Mostly drinking?

4 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

5 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

6 DAVID JONES: Like a lot of times whenever I
7 drink I just (Untranslatable) get me some, you know.

8 DETECTIVE MILLER: Getting some.

9 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

10 DETECTIVE MILLER: Oh, a woman?

11 DAVID JONES: No, the coke.

12 DETECTIVE MILLER: Coke?

13 DAVID JONES: Yeah, something --

14 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

15 DAVID JONES: And --

16 DETECTIVE MILLER: This -- this girl here,
17 ██████████, where did you meet her at that night?

18 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

19 DETECTIVE MILLER: Recall?

20 DAVID JONES: I think, yeah, but I know I was
21 walking.

22 DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.

23 DAVID JONES: And (Untranslatable)

24 DETECTIVE MILLER: Well, was it near the
25 school there? Or --

1 DAVID JONES: Yeah (Untranslatable)
2 DETECTIVE MILLER: On Fig or on Broadway or
3 what?
4 DAVID JONES: Probably on Fig.
5 DETECTIVE MILLER: Fig?
6 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
7 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Fig and what street
8 roughly?
9 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) 99th, 98, or
10 97.
11 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Between 97th and
12 99th?
13 DAVID JONES: Something like that.
14 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. And what kind of
15 discussion did you guys have, you know, go over and
16 smoke a little coke or get a little -- have a little
17 sex? Or what was the offer?
18 DAVID JONES: Yeah, you know, like that, yeah.
19 DETECTIVE MILLER: Well, what was, you know,
20 tell me (Untranslatable)
21 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) I'd say okay.
22 We did that, you know, and that was it. Then I left.
23 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. When --
24 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
25 DETECTIVE MILLER: When -- did she approach

1 you or did you approach her on the street? Did she
2 walk up to you and ask you for a date or, you know,
3 did you ask -- tell -- you -- you approached her?

4 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

5 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. What did you --

6 DAVID JONES: And I asked her -- I asked her
7 what's up for the night, you know.

8 DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.

9 DAVID JONES: She said, "Not too much." I
10 said, "I got a little -- little money, you know, got
11 a little thing (Untranslatable) and she said, "Well,
12 what do you want to do." I said, "I don't got enough
13 for a motel." She said, "Well, let's go
14 (Untranslatable) like that.

15 DETECTIVE MILLER: Smoke you mean?

16 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

17 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So you agreed on
18 going to get it over at the school.

19 DAVID JONES: And that's it.

20 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. You walked -- how'd
21 you get there?

22 DAVID JONES: You got to walk around like
23 (Untranslatable)

24 DETECTIVE MILLER: Down the alley or --

25 DAVID JONES: No, over there where the --

1 where the cars at between that shop and the corner of
2 that street.

3 DETECTIVE MILLER: Oh, the street there at
4 97th where it dead ends there?

5 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

6 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Then they got the
7 big gate into the school?

8 DAVID JONES: Yeah, then they got that
9 (Untranslatable)

10 DETECTIVE MILLER: Is it a little small gate?

11 DAVID JONES: Yeah, yeah.

12 DETECTIVE MILLER: See, the big gate they
13 drive the cars in.

14 DAVID JONES: Yeah, sometimes the big --

15 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

16 DAVID JONES: Sometimes both of them be open.

17 DETECTIVE MILLER: Right.

18 DAVID JONES: Sometime.

19 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So you and her walk
20 down --

21 DAVID JONES: Walking toward the bleachers.

22 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

23 DAVID JONES: And because that's where I
24 wanted -- just in case somebody do come, I'd be like
25 in the open and see.

DAVID JONES: Yeah, no, by the bleachers where you eat your lunch.

DETECTIVE MILLER: Oh, okay.

DAVID JONES: Because like you'll see anybody come --

DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.

DAVID JONES: -- right -- right there by the cafeteria.

DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.

DAVID JONES: You know, like something behind you, something in front of you. Or you can walk up a little bit and you look down and see who coming, who coming across --

DETECTIVE MILLER: So you got a good view from there.

DAVID JONES: Yeah.

DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So what'd you guys do when you got over there?

DAVID JONES: We smoke, you know.

DETECTIVE MILLER: What kind of sex did you have?

DAVID JONES: We didn't -- she did some.

DETECTIVE MILLER: (Untranslatable) head?

1 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

2 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

3 DAVID JONES: I said I didn't want nothing

4 else.

5 DETECTIVE MILLER: You just wanted some head

6 from her, okay.

7 How much rock do you guys smoke? Did

8 she have her own or do you provide her some or --

9 DAVID JONES: I -- I brought a -- a 10.

10 DETECTIVE MILLER: A 10?

11 DAVID JONES: Yeah, and that, you know, I gave

12 her half. I kept half.

13 DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.

14 DAVID JONES: Well (Untranslatable) I don't

15 know whatever she had on her own.

16 DETECTIVE MILLER: Right, but just while she's

17 with you.

18 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

19 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.

20 DAVID JONES: You know, because I

21 (Untranslatable) the night. And after we did that --

22 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. When -- yesterday

23 you told us that she got a little uppie with you.

24 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

25 DETECTIVE MILLER: And --

1 DAVID JONES: Then I start fighting her back
2 and stuff, you know.

3 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Did she hit you
4 first?

5 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

6 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Why did she hit you?

7 DAVID JONES: I don't know. Probably just
8 flaked out.

9 DETECTIVE MILLER: Just flaked out, huh?

10 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

11 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. When she flaked out
12 did she hit you a couple of times or what was -- what
13 happened?

14 DAVID JONES: No, I -- I duck (Untranslatable)

15 DETECTIVE MILLER: You're ducking her punches?

16 DAVID JONES: Yeah, you know (Untranslatable)
17 get out with those girls (Untranslatable)

18 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. When you grabbed
19 her, did you grab her with your left arm or your
20 right arm?

21 DAVID JONES: I just -- I don't know how I
22 grabbed her. I just grabbed her, you know.

23 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So you just --
24 what'd you tell us yesterday? Your strong arm? Is
25 that the -- that's your -- your right arm is your

1 strong arm?

2 DAVID JONES: Yeah, this arm get, you know,
3 sometime it give out.

4 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So what happened
5 once you grabbed her?

6 DAVID JONES: You know, I grabbed her
7 (Untranslatable)

8 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. You grabbed her.
9 How -- you're showing me, you're using your arm. You
10 grab her --

11 DAVID JONES: Yeah, you know, grab by her arm
12 kind of like you do like in wrestling.

13 DETECTIVE MILLER: You got arm around her
14 head, neck area like that?

15 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh, then I said, "Be cool.
16 Be cool." Then I did set her down.

17 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. You laid her down?

18 DAVID JONES: I sat her down.

19 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.

20 DAVID JONES: And she was still breathing.
21 And I said, "Well, I'm going to get out of here, you
22 know, because if I do something I might end up
23 hurting this girl, you know, it'd be like assault and
24 battery."

25 DETECTIVE MILLER: Right.

1 DAVID JONES: Then I left.

2 DETECTIVE MILLER: She was laying down when
3 you left.

4 DAVID JONES: Yeah, she was okay. And then I
5 left. I said, "Well, she come through it."

6 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, when she comes to
7 she's going to be all right and you took off.

8 DAVID JONES: Yeah, yeah.

9 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Do you recall
10 which -- was your right, left arm that you put her
11 down with?

12 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

13 DETECTIVE MILLER: Show you the photo. Maybe
14 that will help you. I'm going to show you the photo
15 of the of the area, okay. I'm going to show you a
16 picture that's got number 19 on it, little circle and
17 19, okay. That's -- is that where you left her?

18 DAVID JONES: Huh-uh.

19 DETECTIVE MILLER: No?

20 DAVID JONES: No, to the right. This the
21 bungalow, see. If like you go -- let me see, that's
22 the front. That's the -- that's the front thing.
23 Like you go right like towards the freeway.

24 DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.

25 DAVID JONES: On Flower.

1 DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.

2 DAVID JONES: That's where we was at.

3 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

4 DAVID JONES: And after that -- I don't know

5 what happened after that.

6 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. But when you put her

7 down, she laid there and you just walked off.

8 DAVID JONES: Yeah, she was -- she was cool.

9 When I left she was cool.

10 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

11 DAVID JONES: You know, she was still

12 breathing and stuff, everything else. Because I know

13 I didn't squeeze -- choke -- squeeze (Untranslatable)

14 DETECTIVE MILLER: You didn't choke her that

15 hard.

16 DAVID JONES: No.

17 DETECTIVE MILLER: (Untranslatable)

18 DAVID JONES: And I did. And (Untranslatable)

19 I said, "I know you -- I know you being high and

20 stuff." And I said, "Girl, just rest." See, because

21 she kind of still looking, you know, her eyes like --

22 like this.

23 DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.

24 DAVID JONES: I said, "Girl (Untranslatable)

25 let me walk out. I'm going to leave."

1 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. That's when you had
2 the choke on her?

3 DAVID JONES: Yeah, that's what I just told
4 her -- I said, "Be cool."

5 DETECTIVE MILLER: Your right arm, okay.
6 You're showing with your right arm like that.

7 DAVID JONES: Like this. I said, "Be cool.
8 I'm going to let you go. Please don't hit me."

9 DETECTIVE MILLER: Then you just let her fall
10 down? You --

11 DAVID JONES: No.

12 DETECTIVE MILLER: You laid her down?

13 DAVID JONES: Yeah, she -- she said, "Okay."
14 I put her down. She still was talking. And I just
15 left.

16 DETECTIVE MILLER: And she was laying down and
17 you just walked off.

18 DAVID JONES: Yeah, she was --

19 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

20 DAVID JONES: I told her -- I said, "Be cool,
21 you know."

22 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Jim, you got any --

23 DETECTIVE HARPER: Where -- where did you --
24 where did you learn how to choke? You -- you said
25 you had a like a -- what do you call that? The kind

1 of hold that you had her in? Well, what do -- do you
2 know what you call that or you just grab her around
3 the neck with your right arm?
4 DAVID JONES: I know -- I know like -- like --
5 like on TV.
6 DETECTIVE HARPER: Like on TV?
7 DAVID JONES: TV, yeah, yeah.
8 DETECTIVE HARPER: Who -- who did you see --
9 who did you see use it on TV?
10 DAVID JONES: Cops on TV. Cops
11 (Untranslatable)
12 DETECTIVE HARPER: Oh, the same kind of choke
13 hold?
14 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
15 DETECTIVE HARPER: Oh, okay.
16 DETECTIVE MILLER: Have you ever been choked
17 like that? Have you?
18 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
19 DETECTIVE MILLER: You have.
20 DETECTIVE HARPER: When was this? Do you
21 remember?
22 DAVID JONES: Around -- I think around 80
23 something.
24 DETECTIVE HARPER: Is that right?
25 DETECTIVE MILLER: Who choked you out?

1 DAVID JONES: A cop.
2 DETECTIVE MILLER: Is that right?
3 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
4 DETECTIVE MILLER: That's how you learned
5 that, huh?
6 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
7 DETECTIVE MILLER: No, it wasn't. It's no
8 fun.
9 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) choked me out.
10 And the next thing I woke up, I was up in -- I was in
11 down in the police station.
12 DETECTIVE MILLER: Is that right? Okay.
13 Okay.
14 The second girl that you said you knew
15 from the area there (Untranslatable) her, Debby.
16 DAVID JONES: This one I did see her around.
17 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.
18 DAVID JONES: Up in the area, you know.
19 DETECTIVE MILLER: When -- when you dated her
20 back in November, do you remember where you met her
21 at?
22 DAVID JONES: November, November. What day?
23 DETECTIVE MILLER: The 16th.
24 DAVID JONES: The 16th?
25 DETECTIVE HARPER: I think it was a Tuesday

1 night or a Monday night.

2 DAVID JONES: Okay. The 16th, 16th, okay.

3 16th I know I be -- I go to (Untranslatable)

4 DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.

5 DAVID JONES: -- every day during the week.

6 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.

7 DAVID JONES: Because I go --

8 DETECTIVE MILLER: This be late in the

9 evening.

10 DAVID JONES: What time?

11 DETECTIVE MILLER: Oh, let's just say around

12 10:00 -- 10:00, midnight, something like that.

13 DETECTIVE HARPER: When all the girls are out.

14 DETECTIVE MILLER: All the girls are, you

15 know.

16 DAVID JONES: Let's see -- okay. I -- I go --

17 like I leave from Taco Bell. I got -- I go home.

18 Then I leave. I hop on the blue line, go to

19 (Untranslatable)

20 DETECTIVE MILLER: Where's that at?

21 DAVID JONES: On San Fernando Road.

22 DETECTIVE MILLER: (Untranslatable).

23 DAVID JONES: San Fernando Road.

24 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

25 DAVID JONES: That's -- see, I go like -- like

1 my little AA meetings and stuff, you know.

2 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Do you recall what
3 time it was when you met her, met [REDACTED]?

4 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) like I left
5 there, stopped by some friends house for -- for a
6 couple of hours. Because sometimes I come a
7 different way.

8 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, okay. So it was --
9 it was dark?

10 DAVID JONES: Because I left my friends house
11 around 7:00.

12 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So where do your
13 friends live?

14 DAVID JONES: Right there on -- off of
15 Florence.

16 DETECTIVE MILLER: Florence and what?

17 DAVID JONES: On Crenshaw.

18 DETECTIVE MILLER: Oh, okay. So how did you
19 get from Florence to Crenshaw back over to Fig?

20 DAVID JONES: See, I got to go home that way.

21 DETECTIVE MILLER: Are you taking the bus? Or
22 you --

23 DAVID JONES: I took the bus.

24 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

25 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

1 DETECTIVE MILLER: So you take the bus from
2 Florence and Fig. I'm sorry, Florence and Western.
3 Then you went back --
4 DETECTIVE HARPER: Crenshaw.
5 DETECTIVE MILLER: -- on Crenshaw.
6 DAVID JONES: Right.
7 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So you get off the
8 bus there near the area. So let's say it's about
9 8:00 now. Now, is that a good time?
10 DAVID JONES: Around 8:00 I stop for a minute.
11 DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh, okay. Where was
12 she at? Which corner was she on?
13 DAVID JONES: But sometime I might -- I see
14 her like every now and then coming --
15 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, that night though.
16 On that night.
17 DAVID JONES: Oh, that night?
18 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.
19 DAVID JONES: Oh, so that night I was -- I
20 was -- I just got off the bus for a minute.
21 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
22 DAVID JONES: Saw some -- some -- because I
23 saw one of the homeboys.
24 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
25 DAVID JONES: And I talked to her. We got

1 high.

2 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. What -- where did
3 you meet her at? Do you remember? Right there on
4 Fig? Or was it --

5 DAVID JONES: Right on Fig.

6 DETECTIVE MILLER: Fig and (Untranslatable)

7 DAVID JONES: And I got off the bus. And the
8 girl was still alive still. We got high
9 (Untranslatable)

10 DETECTIVE HARPER: Where -- but where did
11 you -- was she on 97th by the motel or where? On
12 98th or 99th or where?

13 DAVID JONES: 98th.

14 DETECTIVE HARPER: She was on 98th?

15 DAVID JONES: Sometime I might walk up
16 sometime.

17 DETECTIVE HARPER: Who approached who? Did
18 you approach her?

19 DAVID JONES: She was -- oh, she approached
20 me.

21 DETECTIVE HARPER: And what -- what happened
22 then?

23 DAVID JONES: Then we talk. And we got -- she
24 going to go get some stuff there. Then I
25 (Untranslatable) think a little bit, you know.

1 DETECTIVE HARPER: She asked you?
2 DAVID JONES: And I asked her too.
3 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay.
4 DAVID JONES: Then I -- I started thinking,
5 you know, I said, "No." Then I said, "Uh." I said,
6 "Oh, okay." I said (Untranslatable)
7 DETECTIVE HARPER: Where'd you go?
8 DAVID JONES: Then I went and got a 20 piece
9 of stuff, you know.
10 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay.
11 DAVID JONES: Then we smoked that.
12 DETECTIVE HARPER: Where'd you guys go to
13 smoke it at?
14 DAVID JONES: The same place.
15 DETECTIVE HARPER: At the school?
16 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
17 DETECTIVE HARPER: But in a different
18 location.
19 DAVID JONES: The same place.
20 DETECTIVE HARPER: The same place you smoked
21 with Tammy?
22 DAVID JONES: At the bungalow (Untranslatable)
23 up in the cafeteria area?
24 DETECTIVE HARPER: I'm asking you.
25 DAVID JONES: Yeah, in the cafeteria area

1 where you -- where you eat like where you
2 (Untranslatable) and stuff at.
3 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay. This
4 (Untranslatable) go ahead.
5 DETECTIVE MILLER: Go ahead (Untranslatable)
6 DETECTIVE HARPER You remember yesterday we
7 showed you that picture --
8 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
9 DETECTIVE HARPER: -- by the water fountain
10 there? Do you remember the water fountain on this --
11 this is -- it's number 33.
12 DAVID JONES: Oh, the one -- the one
13 (Untranslatable)
14 DETECTIVE HARPER: (Untranslatable)
15 DAVID JONES: -- right here.
16 DETECTIVE HARPER: Now, you remember -- you
17 remember that gate we showed you right there --
18 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
19 DETECTIVE HARPER: -- on that picture?
20 DAVID JONES: This right here (Untranslatable)
21 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay.
22 DAVID JONES: Sometimes --
23 DETECTIVE HARPER: Is that you -- you told us
24 yesterday what happened where the stairs are right
25 there.

1 DAVID JONES: Yeah, right here. Sometimes
2 these -- sometimes these locked. Sometimes might be
3 unlocked.
4 DETECTIVE HARPER: So when you -- you took --
5 did you take [REDACTED] over there?
6 DAVID JONES: I took her right here. Then she
7 sucked my dick.
8 DETECTIVE HARPER: Well, wait -- okay. Okay.
9 Go ahead.
10 DAVID JONES: Okay. She sucked my dick.
11 DETECTIVE MILLER: Now, was this right here or
12 down the steps? Did you go down the steps where they
13 can't see you?
14 DAVID JONES: Oh, we went down the steps.
15 DETECTIVE MILLER: Oh, okay.
16 DETECTIVE HARPER: You sat at the bottom of
17 the steps?
18 DAVID JONES: Yeah, nobody can see you.
19 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay.
20 DAVID JONES: Then --
21 DETECTIVE HARPER: Because if you go down
22 there you can be hid, right?
23 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
24 DETECTIVE HARPER: Is that -- is that the
25 reason you chose that location?

1 DAVID JONES: No, she wanted to go down there.

2 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay.

3 DAVID JONES: Then we went. And I started
4 thinking. In a way I start wanting it a little bit
5 myself.

6 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay. What happened down
7 on the bottom of the steps?

8 DAVID JONES: Then we smoke (Untranslatable)

9 DETECTIVE HARPER: Uh-huh.

10 DAVID JONES: Then she sucked my dick. And I
11 told her, "Let me go first." Because I don't want
12 nobody to think like that. Then I -- I went, got up,
13 started walking.

14 Then that's when I kind of glanced over.
15 I saw like a little head. And the girl kind of going
16 back or something (Untranslatable)

17 DETECTIVE HARPER: Oh, right here in this area
18 here?

19 DAVID JONES: Like -- like you -- like you be
20 right here.

21 DETECTIVE HARPER: Uh-huh.

22 DAVID JONES: Like coming around that -- that
23 green building, the cafeteria (Untranslatable)

24 DETECTIVE HARPER: Right.

25 DAVID JONES: You will kind of see somebody

1 kind of peeking around.

2 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

3 DETECTIVE HARPER: How -- when you left where
4 was she at?

5 DAVID JONES: She was still down there.

6 DETECTIVE MILLER: By herself?

7 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

8 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Just the two of you
9 down there.

10 DAVID JONES: Yeah, then I started coming up
11 by myself.

12 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. You start going by
13 yourself. Did she come up behind you?

14 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

15 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. She just a little
16 ways behind you.

17 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

18 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

19 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

20 DETECTIVE MILLER: What happened when -- okay.
21 You say this -- this little gate here, was it locked
22 or unlocked that night?

23 DAVID JONES: I don't know (Untranslatable)

24 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. But did you have to
25 climb over it?

1 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

2 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So you climbed over
3 the gate then. You didn't know whether it was locked
4 or not.

5 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

6 DETECTIVE MILLER: But you just climbed it.

7 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

8 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

9 DAVID JONES: Just climbed over.

10 DETECTIVE MILLER: Did she try to climb over
11 it? Or how -- what happened?

12 DAVID JONES: I don't know. I didn't look
13 (Untranslatable)

14 DETECTIVE MILLER: Well, did you hear her?

15 DAVID JONES: When I looked back there I was
16 like on the yard part. Like I went around.

17 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Well, yesterday you
18 said that -- that she fell. You saw her falling back
19 down the steps. Do you remember that?

20 DAVID JONES: Uh.

21 DETECTIVE MILLER: Remember we showed you that
22 picture with -- picture number 22. Remember she's
23 laying down in the steps down there? You said that
24 she fell trying to get over that gate?

25 DAVID JONES: Oh, yeah.

1 DETECTIVE MILLER: Well, is that right or --
2 DAVID JONES: Yes.
3 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
4 DAVID JONES: But I was like -- like I turned
5 the corner.
6 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
7 DAVID JONES: As I turned the corner she
8 was -- that's when she started coming out. I was
9 like, damn, I hope this girl don't hurt herself.
10 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Well, also, you said
11 that you had a little hassle with her. She took a
12 swing at you or --
13 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
14 DETECTIVE MILLER: -- she wanted her money
15 back or something.
16 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) no money
17 (Untranslatable)
18 DETECTIVE HARPER: Well, why did you have the
19 fight with her?
20 DAVID JONES: Because she wanted my money
21 (Untranslatable)
22 DETECTIVE MILLER: (Untranslatable)
23 DETECTIVE HARPER: She wanted your money?
24 DAVID JONES: Because I -- I just got paid at
25 Taco Bell.

1 DETECTIVE HARPER: Yeah.

2 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

3 DAVID JONES: So --

4 DETECTIVE HARPER: So -- so you have -- did

5 she swing at you first or you swing at her first?

6 DAVID JONES: She swing at me.

7 DETECTIVE HARPER: Did you hit her?

8 DETECTIVE MILLER: She landed a blow on you?

9 She hit you?

10 DAVID JONES: Yeah, in the jaw. Then I kind

11 of pushed her back (Untranslatable) calm down. So

12 she -- she falls down (Untranslatable)

13 DETECTIVE MILLER: You said that you had a

14 little hassle -- altercation with her. And she swung

15 at you. And that's when you push her back? Or did

16 you grab her and pull her forward and then push her

17 back?

18 DAVID JONES: I pushed her back.

19 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

20 DAVID JONES: First I did grab her like a man

21 (Untranslatable)

22 DETECTIVE MILLER: I know. Now you're telling

23 the truth. Go ahead. That's what you told us

24 yesterday. Go ahead.

25 DAVID JONES: I did -- I did grab her like a

1 man. Yeah, I did want to hit her. And I said --

2 DETECTIVE HARPER: When you grab her like a
3 man, did you grab her around the neck?

4 DAVID JONES: Just grab her about like this.

5 DETECTIVE MILLER: By the clothing
6 (Untranslatable) her neck?

7 DAVID JONES: Yeah, like this.

8 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

9 DAVID JONES: I just grab her like that. Then
10 I just looked at her. And I said (Untranslatable)

11 DETECTIVE MILLER: No, no, David, now you know
12 better. If she took a big swing at you and hit you
13 in the jaw, you got upset.

14 DAVID JONES: Yeah, I did.

15 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

16 DAVID JONES: No, I didn't -- I didn't -- now,
17 I thought about it. I said, "No, I ain't hitting
18 her."

19 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. You didn't hit her.
20 Did you put the -- the arm around her like you did --
21 you told us yesterday -- you said just a little bit,
22 then you walked away.

23 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

24 DETECTIVE MILLER: Now, you know, you tell us
25 the truth, you know, I'm just trying to repeat what

1 you told us yesterday.

2 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) there's a lot
3 of things I do forget.

4 DETECTIVE MILLER: I know. That's why, you
5 know, I'm just trying to remind you. I'm not trying
6 to tell you what you did. You tell me what you did.
7 But I'm trying to remind -- remember -- jog your
8 memory as to what you told us yesterday.

9 DAVID JONES: And after I did that, you know,
10 I walked away. Came up the stairs. I say to myself,
11 "I'm never getting high with these people over here
12 again."

13 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Well, what happened?
14 Tell us what happened down there.

15 DAVID JONES: Okay. Then -- okay
16 (Untranslatable) we (Untranslatable) leaving.

17 DETECTIVE MILLER: Right.

18 DAVID JONES: Okay. I left. I started
19 walking up, you know.

20 DETECTIVE MILLER: Is that when she hit you,
21 when you started walking up the steps?

22 DAVID JONES: Yeah, yeah.

23 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. You're up here --

24 DAVID JONES: Then she hit me again. Then she
25 went -- then I had -- still had a little piece and I

1 just gave it to her, you know.

2 DETECTIVE MILLER: You're talking about rock
3 cocaine?

4 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

5 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

6 DAVID JONES: I just gave it to her if she
7 just leave me alone, you know.

8 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

9 DAVID JONES: I start -- then I start walking.
10 I said, "I'm going to get out of this school before
11 the damn police -- school police thinking we trying
12 to break in the school.

13 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. What happened --
14 the -- the little fight you had with her, tell us
15 about it, you know, and be truthful. Remember
16 everything.

17 DAVID JONES: Then like she had -- after the
18 little fight we had, it was over.

19 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. That was right here
20 at this -- at the top of it?

21 DAVID JONES: No, this is down.

22 DETECTIVE MILLER: It was down in the bottom.

23 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

24 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

25 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) got up here, I

1 got -- and start walking. And got the
2 (Untranslatable) drugs (Untranslatable) right here
3 (Untranslatable) you know, I walked this way. She
4 could have stood there probably picking up her
5 clothes and stuff.

6 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

7 DAVID JONES: Then she probably just hopped
8 the fence (Untranslatable)

9 DETECTIVE MILLER: So you think she probably
10 tried to hop the fence and she fell and --

11 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

12 DETECTIVE MILLER: Fell down the steps, huh?

13 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh, but I didn't -- after
14 that I didn't even touch her. I (Untranslatable)
15 push her.

16 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. When she fell did
17 you try and see if she was okay or --

18 DAVID JONES: No, I didn't pay no attention
19 once I got around the corner.

20 DETECTIVE MILLER: So -- okay. You're walking
21 up the steps from down there, okay. She's behind
22 you. You have your argument up here or where'd you
23 have the argument?

24 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

25 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. That's --

1 DAVID JONES: Down -- down. We're still down
2 in that hole.

3 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

4 DAVID JONES: Down the stairs still.

5 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Now, she wants more
6 money from you?

7 DAVID JONES: I wouldn't give it to her.

8 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. And that's when she
9 cops you one on the chin?

10 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

11 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. And then what'd you
12 do?

13 DAVID JONES: Grabbed her. Then I kind of go
14 like this and stuff.

15 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. But you show me your
16 right arm in a -- a V, okay. Where -- where was her
17 neck? Say, this is my -- your arm. Where was her
18 neck at?

19 Well, put -- just show me on your arm,
20 okay. You had her --

21 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) then -- then I
22 go like this. Then I just let her go.

23 DETECTIVE HARPER: Were you choking her?

24 DAVID JONES: A little bit.

25 DETECTIVE HARPER: What do you call a little

1 bit?

2 DAVID JONES: You know, like lightly. Like
3 (Untranslatable) you know, something like --
4 something like that. Like lightly.

5 DETECTIVE HARPER: In other words, were you
6 trying to control her?

7 DAVID JONES: Yeah (Untranslatable) hurting --
8 hurting me.

9 DETECTIVE HARPER: So you did have her in a
10 choke. A choke hold with your right arm? Which arm
11 did you use?

12 DAVID JONES: Sometimes kind of
13 (Untranslatable) sometimes just -- just be cool. Be
14 cool. Be cool.

15 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay. You're indicating
16 that you're holding your -- your right arm across
17 your chest and holding your right fist with your left
18 fist, pulling in towards your chest.

19 So you're saying that you're holding
20 her -- her neck right in here in the forearm area?
21 That's where her neck was? Or was it over here?
22 You're just trying to control her.

23 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) it was like in
24 the corner on my arm.

25 DETECTIVE HARPER: Oh, okay. Right in here?

1 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

2 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay. Right at the V is
3 where her neck was.

4 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

5 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay.

6 DAVID JONES: I try to keep her cool.

7 DETECTIVE HARPER: Oh, okay.

8 DAVID JONES: I said, "Girl, let me go." Then
9 she started --

10 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.

11 DAVID JONES: -- arguing and stuff, you know.
12 I (Untranslatable) I just gave her that other piece I
13 had. Just left.

14 DETECTIVE HARPER: Was she screaming?

15 DAVID JONES: Well, we was down there and
16 fussing, you know, arguing.

17 DETECTIVE HARPER: So she was yelling at you.

18 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

19 DETECTIVE HARPER: And you -- okay.

20 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

21 DETECTIVE MILLER: So that's when you control
22 her when she started hitting you and screaming at
23 you, huh?

24 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

25 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. How did all the

1 blood get up here; do you know?
2 DAVID JONES: Huh-uh, I don't know.
3 DETECTIVE MILLER: Did she cut you or anything
4 when she was fighting --
5 DAVID JONES: No.
6 DETECTIVE HARPER: -- with you? None at all,
7 huh?
8 DETECTIVE HARPER: You didn't pop her in the
9 nose, did you?
10 DAVID JONES: I don't know what -- I don't
11 know what we did. It could have been mine. It could
12 have been hers, you know.
13 DETECTIVE HARPER: But it was a fight.
14 DAVID JONES: No, we was downstairs. And
15 after I turned the corner (Untranslatable)
16 DETECTIVE HARPER: Could you -- could you have
17 been bleeding when you came upstairs? Because you
18 don't -- you don't know if it was your blood or hers.
19 DAVID JONES: Well, I could have, you know, I
20 could have, you know.
21 DETECTIVE HARPER: Do you remember if you were
22 bleeding? You don't remember?
23 DAVID JONES: No.
24 DETECTIVE HARPER: Do you remember if she was
25 bleeding? You just remember you guys hitting each

1 other.

2 DAVID JONES: Yeah, so I could have been
3 bleeding. I could not be bleeding, you know.

4 DETECTIVE HARPER: Did -- did you hit her hard
5 enough to make her bleed?

6 DAVID JONES: No.

7 DETECTIVE HARPER: You sure?

8 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) I just grabbed
9 her.

10 DETECTIVE HARPER: You just grabbed her around
11 the neck.

12 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

13 DETECTIVE HARPER: But you did punch her.

14 DAVID JONES: No.

15 DETECTIVE HARPER: You didn't punch her at
16 all? I thought you said you had a fight with her
17 down at the bottom.

18 DAVID JONES: All I did I just grabbed her
19 like this (Untranslatable) that's when
20 (Untranslatable)

21 DETECTIVE HARPER: She was hitting you though.

22 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

23 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay.

24 DAVID JONES: Then after I left I don't know
25 what happened because, you know, down the stairs.

1 DETECTIVE HARPER: Do you think she fell down
2 the stairs?

3 DAVID JONES: A lot of time I -- a lot of time
4 I fall off the roof.

5 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay.

6 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. The last one we're
7 going to talk about is the girl that you met and you
8 went over to the motel. Remember showing you picture
9 number 12. Is that -- remember that motel? Remember
10 you telling us about that?

11 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) next to that
12 car -- where he sell cars.

13 DETECTIVE MILLER: Where's that at?

14 DAVID JONES: Right there on Fig where he
15 sells cars.

16 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. How close is the
17 school to that?

18 DAVID JONES: Right there on the side of the
19 fence, right there behind the alley.

20 DETECTIVE MILLER: Oh, is that the school?
21 Oh, you can see it.

22 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

23 DETECTIVE MILLER: Is that the school back
24 there?

25 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

1 DETECTIVE MILLER: (Untranslatable)
2 DETECTIVE HARPER: If you hop the fence you
3 could just be right in that school then.
4 DAVID JONES: Yeah, and got an alleyway right
5 there.
6 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, okay.
7 DAVID JONES: Like any way.
8 DETECTIVE HARPER: That's right there at -- at
9 97th and Figueroa, right?
10 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
11 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay. This pink motel?
12 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
13 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay.
14 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) this one right
15 here, this motel is the one that has a bad reputation
16 from people --
17 DETECTIVE HARPER: What kind of reputation?
18 DAVID JONES: Always had a bad reputation,
19 people getting (Untranslatable) snuff.
20 DETECTIVE HARPER: Oh, is that right?
21 DAVID JONES: That's why I remember they
22 always tell me to stay away from the area right
23 there.
24 DETECTIVE HARPER: But you always hang around
25 over there, right?

1 DAVID JONES: I barely go over there
2 (Untranslatable)
3 DETECTIVE HARPER: Okay.
4 DETECTIVE MILLER: Well, yesterday, remember
5 you told us that you picked up a girl and you went
6 over there. And you and her had a -- remember the
7 big girl you had the problem with?
8 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) she
9 (Untranslatable)
10 DETECTIVE MILLER: Why don't you tell us what
11 happened about that? Where'd you meet her at first?
12 Right there in the same area?
13 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
14 DETECTIVE MILLER: Right there at 97th and
15 Fig?
16 DAVID JONES: Right in front of the place.

13 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: (Untranslatable)

14 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Do you understand all those
15 rights?

16 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

17 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Keeping those rights in
18 mind, do you wish to speak to me?

19 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

20 DETECTIVE MANSKE: When you would go -- you
21 don't have a steady girlfriend?

5 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And then sometimes you
6 put your mouth on them on the private parts?
7 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
8 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yes?
9 DAVID JONES: Oh, no.
10 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: No. Do they put their
11 mouth on your private parts?
12 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
13 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. Do you know what
14 the term is to ejaculate? Do you know what that
15 means? Do you come?
16 DAVID JONES: I take it out.
17 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. So have you ever
18 reached -- or come in their mouth or inside of them?
19 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
20 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: No. You take it out
21 before you do?
22 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Is there any reason for
24 that?
25 DAVID JONES: Huh?

1 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Is there any reason that
2 you stop before -- you take it out before you
3 (Untranslatable)
4 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
5 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. I just want to
6 make sure we are talking about the same thing.
7 DAVID JONES: Okay.
8 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: That's why I'm a little
9 descriptive. We won't talk about it
10 (Untranslatable) --
11 DAVID JONES: All right.
12 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: -- right now. I'm sorry.
13 Go ahead (Untranslatable). You know, I know -- did
14 you work different hours at Taco Bell?
15 DAVID JONES: Just in the morning.
16 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Just in the morning?
17 DAVID JONES: Yeah, at Taco Bell like 7:00 to
18 11:00.
19 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: 7:00 in the morning until
20 11:00 in the morning?
21 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
22 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And then you have the
23 rest of the day and the night (Untranslatable)
24 DAVID JONES: Yeah. That's why I go -- in the
25 middle -- I go home in the middle. Then I have to go

1 over to the Goodwill.

2 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Oh, because you have two
3 jobs?

4 DAVID JONES: See, the Goodwill, when I got me
5 that job --

6 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Right.

7 DAVID JONES: -- you know, because I was still
8 employed with them --

9 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Right.

10 DAVID JONES: -- working with Taco Bell.

11 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: So you go over to the
12 Goodwill in the afternoon. What time do you get off
13 at the Goodwill when you go?

14 DAVID JONES: 3:00, 3:15

15 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: P.M.? In the afternoon
16 or in the morning?

17 DAVID JONES: In the afternoon.

18 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. You know, I know a
19 lot of times when the girls see that you have a job
20 and you're in your Taco Bell outfit and stuff, they
21 know you have money or they think you have money. So
22 they -- they come on to you, right?

23 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

24 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Because they think, well,
25 I'll get some quick money from you.

DAVID JONES: Yeah.

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Isn't that pretty much what they think?

DAVID JONES: Because if I do it like (Untranslatable) just wear my street clothes, they don't know I got no money.

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yeah.

DAVID JONES: See, if I (Untranslatable) before --

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: They wouldn't have bothered you?

DAVID JONES: Yeah. They'd thought I was just a regular guy.

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yeah. And all the times -- all the girls that you have come in contact with so far, they have all come up to you or have you gone up to some of them?

DAVID JONES: I think every now and then -- sometimes -- sometimes they do walk away from me.

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. But most of the time, they come up to you, right?

DAVID JONES: Yeah.

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. And they probably wouldn't be in the situation if they wouldn't come up to you, right, to begin with?

1 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

2 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: I mean, they wouldn't
3 have been in a situation where, you know, something
4 happened later on where they got a little rough with
5 you?

6 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) sometimes --

7 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Excuse me. I'll be right
8 back.

9 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Sometimes what?

10 DAVID JONES: Well, sometimes I'm a nice guy.
11 I try to be nice, you know (Untranslatable) a woman.
12 Some of them -- some of them just take advantage of
13 them.

14 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Some women do take
15 advantage.

16 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

17 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Well, there is just one
18 person who was like that, a girl. She was like that.
19 She was -- you know, she didn't have a problem with
20 walking up to guys, and sometimes she took advantage
21 of some of them. And that's who I'm pretty much
22 concerned about.

23 Okay. And if I show you a photograph of
24 her, I want you to look at her face, and I want you
25 to explain to me everything that happened and how it

1 happened as far as if you recognize her. And I think
2 you will, and --

3 DAVID JONES: Where is this girl from?

4 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: She's from over here
5 by -- near where you live. (Untranslatable). I'll
6 put these back, and we'll get a good picture of her.

7 And this girl, she -- she would
8 around -- sometimes she would go to Century, and
9 sometimes she would go to Imperial, and sometimes she
10 would go to Vermont, and sometimes she would go to
11 Hoover, and sometimes she would go to Figueroa. So
12 that's like near where you kind of go, right?

13 Where's the Goodwill at?

14 DAVID JONES: Well, you know, going like this
15 way to San Fernando Road.

16 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: On (Untranslatable)

17 DAVID JONES: San Fernando.

18 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: San Fernando?

19 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

20 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Oh, down in downtown
21 L.A.?

22 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Or down by --

24 DAVID JONES: Like you (Untranslatable)

25 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Uh-huh.

1 DAVID JONES: On (Untranslatable) Street.
2 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. How do you get
3 there?
4 DAVID JONES: I think it was -- take Broadway.
5 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: (Untranslatable). I'm
6 sorry. (Untranslatable). How do you get there as
7 far as a ride? Do you have a car?
8 DAVID JONES: By bus.
9 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: All the time by bus or do
10 sometimes family members take you?
11 DAVID JONES: No. I always go by bus.
12 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: You always go by bus.
13 Okay. Now, this one girl, her name was [REDACTED]. Do
14 you know any girl named [REDACTED]? Can you remember
15 (Untranslatable)?
16 She's a little short girl, and she had
17 like a little black Afro. And she was wearing a red
18 top and some white pants. Do you remember that? You
19 don't remember that?
20 DAVID JONES: No. I don't remember her
21 because I know most everybody in the neighborhood.
22 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Uh-huh. She's real cute.
23 DAVID JONES: I kind of most know everybody in
24 the neighborhood around there.
25 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Hold on a minute. Let me

1 see if I have a good picture of her. I know I do.
2 (Interruption in the proceedings)
3 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) because when I
4 leave from Goodwill --
5 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Uh-huh.
6 DAVID JONES: -- I get home around night.
7 DETECTIVE MANSKE: You go all over though,
8 right? You have been all over South L.A., over on
9 Florence (Untranslatable)
10 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Imperial Highway.
11 DAVID JONES: I don't go over there. I don't
12 go back there.
13 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: How long have you lived
14 in L.A.?
15 DAVID JONES: A long time.
16 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: So you know the ins and
17 outs of L.A. You know the freeways and
18 (Untranslatable), and that's okay.
19 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
20 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yeah. I mean, this isn't
21 a trick question. I'm not trying to trick you.
22 DAVID JONES: Like sometimes, you know, I
23 go -- like I go (Untranslatable). I go like the Blue
24 Line, hop on the Blue Line.
25 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Oh, okay.

1 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

2 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. I know which one

3 she is. Okay. See this girl in the pink. Do you

4 remember her? In the pink dress, not the one

5 (Untranslatable) girl on the left.

6 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) little boy?

7 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: With the little boy,

8 yeah. She's wearing that pink dress.

9 DETECTIVE MANSKE: She looks -- she looks nice

10 and innocent in that picture, but she fights all the

11 time with people, all the time.

12 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) in my

13 neighborhood so far. (Untranslatable) you know, if I

14 didn't pay no attention because I see a lot of -- a

15 lot of people be over there.

16 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Well, she is in your

17 neighborhood. She lives in your neighborhood.

18 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And see, the same thing

19 kind of happened to her that happened to a couple of

20 the other girls that --

21 DAVID JONES: Well --

22 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Like the ones at the

23 school and stuff, you know. And so that's why I know

24 you probably know her. You probably just don't

25 recognize her face.

1 And she probably fought because she was
2 a fighter. She was real feisty, but she liked to
3 have sex. And so I just need to know what happened.
4 You know, like you said, most of the time it was
5 self-defense, and that's fine.

6 DAVID JONES: I didn't say that. She got
7 killed on Imperial?

8 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: No. I didn't say that.

9 DAVID JONES: Oh, all right.

10 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. That's where she
11 was (Untranslatable). That's where she
12 (Untranslatable). You can find her at Imperial or
13 Century or Vermont or Hoover or Figueroa. That's
14 where she was always around.

15 DAVID JONES: If I did, I don't know.

16 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. Do you -- some of
17 the girls that fought with you, you moved them from
18 wherever they were, right, like sometimes where you
19 were -- where you were originally. Then the fight
20 took place, and then you started -- you were just
21 trying to defend yourself?

22 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And then you kind of had
24 to move them around or something? Is that what
25 happened?

1 DAVID JONES: No. They were still --
2 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: How did that happen?
3 DAVID JONES: They were still alive, you know.
4 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: They were -- well, okay.
5 DAVID JONES: Okay. Like -- okay. Like the
6 same thing like -- for instance (Untranslatable)
7 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Uh-huh.
8 DAVID JONES: -- and stuff (Untranslatable)
9 and comes back to his senses, you know.
10 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Well, when some of the
11 girls fought, and they were like just laying there,
12 did you ever try to cover them up or did you ever try
13 to, you know, make sure that they were okay?
14 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
15 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And did you ever cover
16 any of them up?
17 DAVID JONES: Huh-uh.
18 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: No?
19 DAVID JONES: I tried like -- I had some soda,
20 and I tried to give them some soda, you know.
21 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Some soda?
22 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable). And they was
23 okay.
24 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: When you left, they were
25 okay?

1 DAVID JONES: They was okay (Untranslatable)
2 DETECTIVE MANSKE: What did you do when you
3 were fighting with them?
4 DAVID JONES: I tried to get -- I tried to get
5 (Untranslatable)
6 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah. But I mean, what did
7 you do? I mean, did you hit them?
8 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
9 DETECTIVE MANSKE: And --
10 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: With the fist or just an
11 open hand?
12 DAVID JONES: Sometimes with an open hand, and
13 sometimes I slapped them out of the way, you know.
14 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Sometimes with your fist?
15 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh, because he hit me with
16 his.
17 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.
18 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable). So he decided
19 to take my money from me, and I ain't going to let
20 nobody take (Untranslatable)
21 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.
22 DAVID JONES: I work hard for it. And
23 (Untranslatable) I don't know what happened.
24 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Did they ever hit you?
25 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

1 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Did it make you bleed?
2 DAVID JONES: No. I had a couple of bruises.
3 He hit me in the nose once, and I started to bleed.
4 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Oh, he did? How about --
5 how about on your arms? Did they mark you up at all?
6 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
7 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Did they ever bite you or
8 anything like that?
9 DAVID JONES: Because I was (Untranslatable)
10 with my hand back and stuff.
11 DETECTIVE MANSKE: What do you mean with your
12 hand back?
13 DAVID JONES: Because like every time
14 (Untranslatable) bite me or something
15 (Untranslatable)
16 DETECTIVE MANSKE: How did you -- how did you
17 put your arm on the net?
18 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) choke them out.
19 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Choke them out?
20 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
21 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Like what?
22 DAVID JONES: Like the police hold.
23 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Like the police hold?
24 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
25 DETECTIVE MANSKE: How do you know the police

1 my mother's house.

2 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Where's that?

3 DAVID JONES: On 103rd.

4 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And what?

5 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) San Pedro.

6 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: You are on San Pedro.

7 Okay. So you go that far east. And then --

8 DAVID JONES: No. See --

9 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: (Untranslatable)

10 DAVID JONES: -- that's -- that's why I was

11 staying at my mother's.

12 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. And then where

13 else do you go to buy sometimes?

14 DAVID JONES: It's right down there.

15 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Where at?

16 DAVID JONES: Sometimes up farther up the

17 street.

18 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Where at?

19 DAVID JONES: On 102nd.

20 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And where else?

21 DAVID JONES: That's it.

22 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: 102nd and what?

23 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) San Pedro --

24 Main.

25 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. I didn't mean to

1 interrupt you. Go ahead.

2 DAVID JONES: And a lot of times I just go
3 home with mine. I go in the house and smoke.

4 DETECTIVE MANSKE: When these girls would
5 fight -- fight you -- fight with you, and the more
6 they fought, the more you would have to hit them or
7 choke them or --

8 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

9 DETECTIVE MANSKE: What do you call it? What
10 do you call that? Just a choke hold?

11 DAVID JONES: No. (Untranslatable) like right
12 here. In other words, I was kind of slowing down.

13 DETECTIVE MANSKE: What do the police call
14 that?

15 DAVID JONES: A choke hold.

16 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. So I'll just call it
17 a choke hold, okay, just to make things easy. How's
18 that?

19 DAVID JONES: He was okay after I left him.
20 He was still breathing.

21 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

22 DAVID JONES: Because I put my chest right
23 here.

24 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

25 DAVID JONES: The heart is still going. I put

1 my hand right here. She was still breathing.

2 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

3 DAVID JONES: I stayed there about a few

4 minutes until she came through. I gave her some

5 water. I put some water in her face and walked off.

6 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. Let's go

7 (Untranslatable). When she started fighting with you

8 (Untranslatable) wants money.

9 DAVID JONES: See, her (Untranslatable). I

10 don't know the date of that.

11 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Do we have another picture

12 of her --

13 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: No.

14 DETECTIVE MANSKE: -- another picture of her?

15 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Except for the ones that

16 we have in these books.

17 DAVID JONES: And her -- I never dated her.

18 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Because she liked cocaine.

19 DAVID JONES: I know. But see, a lot of

20 people in my mother's neighborhood smoked it.

21 DETECTIVE MANSKE: She liked cocaine. She

22 smoked it, and she liked sex.

23 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

24 DETECTIVE MANSKE: She would do anything for

25 money --

1 DAVID JONES: I know.

2 DETECTIVE MANSKE: -- to get cocaine.

3 DAVID JONES: See, some people on my street

4 (Untranslatable) too.

5 DETECTIVE MANSKE: And she (Untranslatable)

6 with the people that, you know, she's trying to get

7 money from. And that's her (Untranslatable). She's

8 kind of (Untranslatable)

9 DAVID JONES: I don't know about that.

10 DETECTIVE MANSKE: And, you know, you being a

11 man that (Untranslatable) to have money

12 (Untranslatable)

13 DAVID JONES: A lot of times I don't.

14 DETECTIVE MANSKE: But you dress -- you dress

15 like you do so, you know, I'm thinking she probably

16 took advantage of you.

17 DAVID JONES: No.

18 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: She tried?

19 DETECTIVE MANSKE: And -- and --

20 DAVID JONES: I don't know. Yeah, she tried

21 because one day -- I mean, I don't know. I'll never

22 forget. I did have my check in my pocket. I never

23 cashed it.

24 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

25 DAVID JONES: And I told her I was going --

1 you know, I was going to go cash it. I went in the
2 house and stayed and gave my check to my mother.

3 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

4 DAVID JONES: And I stayed in the house. She
5 was outside waiting. She was waiting -- she was
6 waiting, and I didn't come back out. I looked
7 outside. She was gone.

8 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

9 DAVID JONES: So I did have \$45 in my pocket,
10 but she didn't know that. See, she didn't know that.

11 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Well, what did she do
12 exactly? What was the first thing that she would do
13 to try to take advantage or try to take your money?
14 Just go in your pockets?

15 DAVID JONES: Huh-uh. I didn't go in no
16 pockets.

17 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Did she?

18 DAVID JONES: Huh-uh.

19 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: She didn't go in your
20 pockets?

21 DAVID JONES: No, because I told her I didn't
22 have none.

23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And she believed you?

24 DAVID JONES: I don't know. I think so.
25 Because I didn't go in no pockets. I was -- if I

1 (Untranslatable) my pockets like this, then I know
2 what she was about to do.

3 And I went in the house because I wasn't
4 too far from the house because I (Untranslatable) go
5 in the house so as to get my I.D. because I had my
6 I.D. in my pocket all the time because I was trying
7 to straighten out my act, you know, try not to smoke
8 nothing, you know, try to go to my little drug
9 program at the (Untranslatable) place and stuff.

10 And I stayed in the house. I stayed. I
11 stayed. I took off my clothes, put on my pajamas and
12 stuff. Then she just stood out there and stood out
13 there. Then she left. Then about a couple of weeks
14 later, I didn't see her no more. I didn't know what
15 happened.

16 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: When was this? Do you
17 remember when this -- was this before Christmas?

18 DAVID JONES: I don't know. I don't know if
19 it was before Christmas. I know I've
20 (Untranslatable)

21 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Was it before
22 Thanksgiving? Do you remember Thanksgiving?

23 DAVID JONES: Yes. (Untranslatable)

24 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. So you think it
25 was before Thanksgiving?

1 DAVID JONES: Something like that.

2 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. What did -- do you
3 remember Halloween when all the kids were all dressed
4 up and trick-or-treating?

5 DAVID JONES: I went over to my aunt's that
6 day (Untranslatable)

7 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. Was it before that
8 with this girl?

9 DAVID JONES: Yeah. But I remember because
10 that (Untranslatable). But I was wearing like my
11 uniform all the time. Sometimes -- every now and
12 then (Untranslatable)

13 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. Was it -- was it
14 like during the summer or after the summer or was it
15 like even before the summer?

16 DAVID JONES: I don't know. It goes so fast,
17 you know.

18 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yeah, I know. Do you
19 remember -- were you wearing a jacket when this
20 happened?

21 DAVID JONES: I don't know. (Untranslatable)
22 like in the middle between hot and cold like kind of
23 off and on.

24 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Oh, okay.

25 DAVID JONES: So like every now and then you

1 might have to wear a jacket this day, and sometimes
2 you might wear no jacket that day.

3 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Uh-huh.

4 DAVID JONES: Because I did -- I stayed in the
5 house, and I gave my check to my mother because like
6 my counselor, he controls my money and stuff like
7 that.

8 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. Now, this girl --
9 when you left her, she was breathing, right?

10 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

11 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Did you -- did you cover
12 her up to keep her warm from --

13 DAVID JONES: A coat she had, you know.

14 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: She had a coat?

15 DAVID JONES: A coat she had so far. I think
16 she came back to her senses, and she could have rent
17 her another date or something. It could possibly be,
18 went to another date or something.

19 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay.

20 DAVID JONES: And that date "boom, pow, boom,
21 boom."

22 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yeah. But when you had
23 your date with her, where did you have your date with
24 her at?

25 DAVID JONES: At the (Untranslatable) the

1 cafeteria area.

2 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. And then how
3 did -- and then where did you go after that?

4 DAVID JONES: I left.

5 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. You left her
6 there?

7 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. I just kind of left her
8 there. She was still -- she was saying she wanted to
9 stay there and lay down for a minute.

10 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. So this was laying
11 down?

12 DAVID JONES: Yeah. Okay. I left. I told
13 her, "Just be careful." (Untranslatable)

14 DETECTIVE MANSKE: What about the -- what
15 about the girl that -- that you left by the alley?

16 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

17 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: The one you left by the
18 alley.

19 DAVID JONES: By the motel?

20 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yeah. There was a motel
21 near there.

22 DAVID JONES: Inside the alley or up in the
23 motel?

24 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Not the one inside the
25 motel. There was one inside a motel.

1 (Untranslatable)

2 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

3 DETECTIVE MANSKE: (Untranslatable) or
4 something.

5 DAVID JONES: All right. (Untranslatable)
6 over two years.

7 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Oh, okay.

8 DAVID JONES: This is about two year's old.

9 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. This girl that you
10 were with, she had a choke hold on her too.

11 DAVID JONES: The one that was in the alley?

12 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah.

13 DAVID JONES: I don't know about that one.

14 DETECTIVE MANSKE: And the same -- the same
15 that -- the same things -- you know, she fought. So
16 we know she fought with you. Okay. And we think
17 that you probably left her there, and then somebody
18 else came and beat her up some more.

19 DAVID JONES: I don't know about that one in
20 the alley.

21 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. We're going to show
22 you her picture. Okay?

23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: She looked pretty bad,
24 but those -- all that right there, that's really
25 nothing. That's just superficial stuff.

1 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
2 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yeah.
3 DAVID JONES: I don't remember
4 (Untranslatable). I don't remember (Untranslatable).
5 I never had no date with her.
6 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: You could have and you
7 just don't remember?
8 DAVID JONES: Because if I ever had a date, I
9 would have (Untranslatable)
10 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: You had dates at night
11 sometimes, at nighttime?
12 DAVID JONES: Sometimes days.
13 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And sometimes at night?
14 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
15 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Is that yes?
16 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
17 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. So sometimes you
18 might not have had a good look at them as much as you
19 try to have a good look because the lights aren't --
20 the lighting isn't real good, right?
21 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
22 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. And see, I
23 don't -- I don't think this is what you did to her.
24 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
25 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: I think you left her

1 alive like all the other girls, and either she
2 crawled out into the alley and someone else saw her
3 or she got up and she started walking in the alley.
4 I don't know, but I don't -- you know, I don't think
5 this is what you did to her.

6 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. Because I don't -- I
7 don't like -- I don't like to do that to no female.

8 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: No, no, no. See, I
9 understand that when you did have to defend yourself,
10 you did -- you only used that amount of force that
11 you had to to get away from them. You didn't overdo
12 it. I understand that. I know you wouldn't do
13 something like that just to be mean or spiteful.

14 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

15 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And that's what -- but I
16 think that maybe you were trying to defend yourself
17 and get away from her when she turned on you. And
18 when you checked on her, she was alive when you left
19 her.

20 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. Because I did. I
21 checked -- I always checked (Untranslatable). I
22 always checked.

23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. Well --

24 DAVID JONES: You know, I did like this to
25 (Untranslatable) she was still breathing, everything,

1 the whole shot.

2 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: This girl here?

3 DAVID JONES: The whole shot.

4 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: This one right here,
5 right?

6 DAVID JONES: The whole shot.

7 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: This one right here,
8 right?

9 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. The whole shot.

10 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. Where did you get
11 the blanket from?

12 DAVID JONES: I don't know where the blanket
13 came from.

14 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: When you left her, she
15 didn't have the blanket?

16 DAVID JONES: I didn't -- when I seen her,
17 there was no blanket period.

18 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Did you try and cover her
19 up with a blanket, you know, so she would stay warm?

20 DAVID JONES: Yeah. You know, I try to tell
21 her to put your clothes on and stuff like that
22 because she didn't have no clothes on when I left
23 her.

24 DETECTIVE MANSKE: She didn't?

25 DAVID JONES: When I left her, she did.

1 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: What kind of clothes did
2 she have on?

3 DAVID JONES: I think it was black -- brown
4 (Untranslatable) color. I forgot what color. It was
5 kind of dark -- light colors or something.

6 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Light colors?

7 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

8 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Tan?

9 DAVID JONES: Something like that. But I
10 didn't pay no attention to what the color was.

11 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Did you have sex with
12 this girl?

13 DAVID JONES: Oh, no.

14 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: You didn't have sex with
15 her?

16 DAVID JONES: No.

17 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Not oral sex? She didn't
18 put her mouth on your private parts?

19 DAVID JONES: Just that.

20 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay.

21 DAVID JONES: Just that part.
22 (Untranslatable)

23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Oral sex?

24 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

25 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. So she put her

1 mouth on your penis?

2 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

3 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay.

4 DAVID JONES: That's as far as I went.

5 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. Were you standing
6 or sitting down?

7 DAVID JONES: Standing.

8 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: You were standing. Was
9 she on her knees or just bending over?

10 DAVID JONES: On her knees.

11 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: She was on her knees.
12 And where were you standing at? Where --

13 DAVID JONES: I think in -- like in a dark
14 part.

15 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: In the dark part of the
16 alley?

17 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

18 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Were you up against a
19 fence or were you up against a house or were you up
20 against a tree or --

21 DAVID JONES: There's houses (Untranslatable)

22 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: There were houses?

23 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. Like they was a duplex.

24 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay.

25 DAVID JONES: About two duplexes.

1 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. Hold on. Let me
2 see if I have the duplexes here.

3 DETECTIVE MANSKE: I'll be right back. I've
4 got to use the bathroom.

5 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

6 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. Now, when you took
7 her -- when you were at the duplexes having -- she
8 was on her knees -- I'm looking for those duplexes
9 now.

10 DAVID JONES: Where did you find this one at?

11 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: It was right there right
12 near where you were.

13 DAVID JONES: On Imperial?

14 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Uh-huh.

15 DAVID JONES: No. I don't hang over on
16 Imperial.

17 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: No. We don't think you
18 were over there hanging. I think you just -- she
19 just took you over there because that's where -- she
20 knows all those spots. And there's a duplex right
21 there, and there's the alley and --

22 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: We'll have to take you
24 out there, I think, because you can show us right
25 where she was. Then how far down the alley did you

1 go after she --

2 DAVID JONES: I thought we're talking about
3 over here on Figueroa.

4 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Right, right. It's not
5 far from Figueroa.

6 DAVID JONES: Not too far from Figueroa?

7 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Huh-uh.

8 DAVID JONES: East and west.

9 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Well, where were you
10 right near those duplexes? Where the duplexes --

11 DAVID JONES: We was right here between 96th
12 and 95th.

13 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Those duplexes you are
14 talking about are on 96th and 95th?

15 DAVID JONES: Yes.

16 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Because right where she
17 was at in the alley near the duplexes -- there were
18 duplexes, but it wasn't over at 95th and 96th. Look
19 at her face again.

20 DAVID JONES: Because I was -- because you've
21 got to like turn (Untranslatable). You've got
22 duplexes over here.

23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Well, there's -- that
24 sounds exactly like this place here.

25 DAVID JONES: That's the part -- the only

1 thing (Untranslatable)

2 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: So you were right outside
3 of the duplexes in the alley when she was --

4 DAVID JONES: Because I seen her probably that
5 night. She's the -- that's the one that
6 (Untranslatable) me down.

7 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Uh-huh. Well, you just
8 told me she had oral sex with you.

9 DAVID JONES: That was probably that night.

10 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Oh, okay. Earlier in the
11 day?

12 DAVID JONES: Yeah. That's the last time I
13 seen her.

14 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And what time was that?

15 DAVID JONES: Around three, four o'clock in
16 the afternoon. That's the last time I seen her
17 alive, and (Untranslatable) is she got her hand
18 stuck.

19 That's from being -- that was one time
20 (Untranslatable) night. And I wanted to go back
21 (Untranslatable) again (Untranslatable) the same
22 thing. (Untranslatable) I just walked away.

23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: What time did you go back
24 to her?

25 DAVID JONES: I didn't go back.

1 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Well, you said you went
2 back, but she (Untranslatable)
3 DAVID JONES: That was the same day.
4 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yeah. But what time was
5 that?
6 DAVID JONES: Around three something or four
7 something.
8 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Well, that was the first
9 time you were with her.
10 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
11 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And then you went back,
12 you said.
13 DAVID JONES: Yeah. (Untranslatable)
14 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: What time did you go
15 back?
16 DAVID JONES: I would say around four
17 something or 5:00.
18 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Well, you went back and saw
19 her. This was after dark when you saw her, right?
20 DAVID JONES: One time before dark and
21 (Untranslatable)
22 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Then you saw her again when
23 it was dark?
24 DAVID JONES: Yeah. That time I was --
25 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: High?

1 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

2 DETECTIVE MANSKE: You were --

3 DAVID JONES: Drunk.

4 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Drunk?

5 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Drunk?

6 DAVID JONES: Yeah. By that time, I was

7 drunk. I was drinking like brandy --

8 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

9 DAVID JONES: -- and coke.

10 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Did she like that? I mean,

11 did she want some?

12 DAVID JONES: I gave her some.

13 DETECTIVE MANSKE: You gave her some. And --

14 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

15 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Why did she get mad at you?

16 The money?

17 DAVID JONES: Yeah. I told her no.

18 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Is that because you didn't

19 have any money?

20 DAVID JONES: I did.

21 DETECTIVE MANSKE: You just didn't want to pay

22 her?

23 DAVID JONES: I did pay her.

24 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: How much?

25 DAVID JONES: 20.

1 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: You paid her \$20. And
2 where did you first -- where was she at when you
3 first saw her?
4 DAVID JONES: When I first saw her, that was
5 right there on Fig.
6 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: On Figueroa and what?
7 DAVID JONES: And 96th.
8 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: 96th?
9 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) or between 97th
10 and (Untranslatable)
11 DETECTIVE MANSKE: And when she started
12 arguing with you, you had to choke her a little bit
13 to calm her down?
14 DAVID JONES: I did.
15 DETECTIVE MANSKE: You did to calm her down?
16 DAVID JONES: Her eyes starting going back
17 right here. So I said (Untranslatable)
18 DETECTIVE MANSKE: So you stopped then?
19 DAVID JONES: Yeah -- no --
20 DETECTIVE MANSKE: You just kept --
21 DAVID JONES: This was before all this stuff
22 started happening.
23 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay.
24 DAVID JONES: You know, I saw her eyes going
25 back. I kind of looked (Untranslatable)

1 (Interruption in the proceedings)

2 DETECTIVE MANSKE: This was all dark when all

3 this was happening; is that right? You do go out at

4 night?

5 DAVID JONES: Sometimes.

6 DETECTIVE MANSKE: A lot of this stuff happens

7 at night?

8 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

9 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Because like over at the

10 school -- you don't go over to the school when the

11 children are there, do you?

12 DAVID JONES: No.

13 DETECTIVE MANSKE: So you go -- most of your

14 stuff is done at night then after it gets dark?

15 DAVID JONES: Yeah. And sometimes my -- I do

16 it at home.

17 DETECTIVE MANSKE: At home?

18 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. (Untranslatable). Like

19 I do it at home. My mother is gone. "Bam, bam,

20 bam." I pay the girl, and she leaves.

21 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh. Are those the ones

22 that never -- the ones that don't fight you? Is that

23 the ones you have --

24 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable). See, they

25 know me real good.

1 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

2 DAVID JONES: So I told her we can, you know,
3 fight each other --

4 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

5 DAVID JONES: -- and stuff like that. So they
6 know me. I know them. Because I (Untranslatable).
7 I know where they stay at.

8 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

9 DAVID JONES: And some of them know where I
10 stay at.

11 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. Well, let's go right
12 here. Okay. When you had to choke her to calm her
13 down and you said her eyes were rolling up in her
14 head --

15 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) smoking her
16 stuff.

17 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

18 DAVID JONES: You know, she smokes. She hits
19 that stuff so hard.

20 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah. Well, I know she
21 hits that stuff real hard.

22 DAVID JONES: "Bam, bam." Her eyes starting
23 rolling back. I looked at -- I kind of
24 (Untranslatable) ease away from her (Untranslatable)

25 DETECTIVE MANSKE: But then she started -- did

1 she start hitting you and --

2 DAVID JONES: Yeah. That's when she got
3 that -- some stick, you know. (Untranslatable). I
4 ran. I started running.

5 DETECTIVE MANSKE: She got a stick? She
6 picked it up there in the alley?

7 DAVID JONES: Some kind of a stick or
8 something, you know. I didn't get a good look at it.
9 And I started running.

10 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

11 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

12 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

13 DAVID JONES: I said, "Oh, man." I didn't
14 have no choice but fight.

15 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

16 DAVID JONES: I said, "Damn. Why? Why? Why?
17 I mean, why?" You see, every time I was getting like
18 a setup.

19 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

20 DAVID JONES: Always -- my mother is always
21 telling me, "Leave those people alone. Leave them
22 alone --"

23 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

24 DAVID JONES: -- "or something may happen. You
25 might end up -- they might end up hurting you or they

1 might, you know, hurt you."
2 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah. Okay. So you didn't
3 really try to hurt her. You were just choking her to
4 keep her from hurting you?
5 DAVID JONES: Yeah. (Untranslatable). It's
6 like kill her, kill her. I want to kill
7 (Untranslatable) like that. I was being kind of --
8 be calm, be calm, be calm.
9 DETECTIVE MANSKE: And she passed out?
10 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) damn.
11 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Well, when she was -- when
12 she was fighting you -- also, some of the other
13 girls, I'm sure this would happen too. Did you hit
14 them --
15 DAVID JONES: I kind of --
16 DETECTIVE MANSKE: -- you know, to try and get
17 them calmed down?
18 DAVID JONES: I hit them just "Bam."
19 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. When you hit, which
20 arm would you normally use?
21 DAVID JONES: This one.
22 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Your right arm?
23 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. See, but most of the
24 time when I hit them, I kind of hurt my hand. I
25 said, "Damn."

1 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Would you reach around with
2 your left hand and hit them then?
3 DAVID JONES: Yeah. I wait. Then I kind
4 of -- she swung the stick. I ducked. That's why
5 I --
6 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Grab her. And then you hit
7 her a couple of times?
8 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. Then I was grabbing. I
9 said, "Come on, come on." And she was -- she conked
10 out.
11 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.
12 DAVID JONES: She just went. So I said,
13 "Okay. Now, this is the best time to walk away."
14 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.
15 DAVID JONES: I walked away. Whatever
16 happened -- like when I left, she was still cool.
17 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.
18 DAVID JONES: Once I left, I was gone. And
19 she must have got another date from somebody else --
20 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.
21 DAVID JONES: -- and she (Untranslatable)
22 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. Where did you get
23 the blanket that you covered her up with?
24 DAVID JONES: I don't know where that blanket
25 come from.

1 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Was it laying in the alley?
2 DAVID JONES: I didn't notice.
3 DETECTIVE MANSKE: But she didn't have any
4 clothes on when you left her, right?
5 DAVID JONES: She didn't have any clothes on
6 when we ran into -- when we ran into each other.
7 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Well, no. When you were
8 fighting with her -- all right. After she had the
9 sex with you -- try and understand this.
10 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
11 DETECTIVE MANSKE: (Untranslatable) she didn't
12 have any clothes on, did she?
13 DAVID JONES: Yeah. I ran into her on the
14 street, yeah.
15 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah, when you ran into her
16 on the street. But I'm talking about back in the
17 alley.
18 DAVID JONES: Oh (Untranslatable)
19 DETECTIVE MANSKE: She was hitting you and all
20 of that.
21 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
22 DETECTIVE MANSKE: She took all of
23 (Untranslatable) clothes off, right?
24 DAVID JONES: No. (Untranslatable). I told
25 her to keep them on.

1 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Would you -- I'm sorry.
2 Where are we at here?
3 DETECTIVE MANSKE: I was just going back over
4 it again trying to --
5 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Do you recognize her now?
6 DETECTIVE MANSKE: (Untranslatable) up the
7 alley.
8 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: You do recognize her now,
9 right?
10 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
11 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And you did have sex with
12 her or she put her mouth on you?
13 DAVID JONES: Yeah. She just put the mouth.
14 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: How much did you pay her
15 for that?
16 DAVID JONES: 20.
17 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: 20. Wow, no wonder the
18 girls like you.
19 DAVID JONES: Hey, that's why she wanted to
20 take the rest of it.
21 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: How much did you have?
22 DAVID JONES: About \$275.
23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: What else was she going
24 to do for that?
25 DAVID JONES: She didn't know -- she didn't

1 know about the \$275.

2 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yeah. But you said that
3 after she saw -- after you paid her 20, she wanted to
4 take the rest of it.

5 DAVID JONES: Yeah. She probably figured I
6 had more.

7 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And what was -- she
8 wanted to have more sex with you or what?

9 DAVID JONES: Yeah. She wanted to do the
10 whole shebang.

11 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Shebang? What's a
12 shebang?

13 DAVID JONES: The whole works.

14 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Oh, is that right? What
15 does the whole works include?

16 DAVID JONES: You know.

17 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: I know, but you have --

18 DAVID JONES: The same thing like you put on a
19 hamburger with the whole shot. It's like that.

20 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Well, I never heard it
21 put quite that way.

22 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: It's not like putting
24 like everything on a hamburger.

25 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

1 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. And how much did
2 she want for that, for the whole shebang?
3 DAVID JONES: A hundred bucks. You know, I
4 said, "No way." I said, "No way." (Untranslatable)
5 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay.
6 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) say, "Come on,
7 let's smoke some more." I said, "No, no."
8 (Untranslatable) I'm getting up in the morning to go
9 to work.
10 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And then what happened?
11 DAVID JONES: And that's when the whole Fourth
12 of July just went off, "poof." I noticed her eyes
13 started shifting back over -- over her head. I said,
14 "Have you been smoking that stuff?"
15 I looked at her and I said, "Oh, oh,
16 there it goes," in my head. I sort of eased away.
17 They only thing that blocked -- that stopped me was
18 this wall. And that's when the stick came up in the
19 picture.
20 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: The what?
21 DAVID JONES: The stick came up in the
22 picture.
23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: The state?
24 DAVID JONES: The stick.
25 DETECTIVE MANSKE: The stick. She picked up a

1 stick or a board.

2 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Oh, okay. Is that why
3 she doesn't -- you see, she doesn't have a top on.
4 Is that because she was taking her clothes off
5 wanting the whole shebang? So she took her own
6 clothes off --

7 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

8 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: -- saying that -- kind of
9 like wanting more? Okay. What did she do with her
10 clothes? She just put them down on the floor?

11 DAVID JONES: Right. She put the top -- she
12 started taking the rest all off. So --

13 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay.

14 DAVID JONES: -- I told her (Untranslatable)

15 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: So she picked up a stick.
16 She got mad.

17 DAVID JONES: Yeah. (Untranslatable) stuff
18 like that.

19 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. And then what else
20 happened? Then what happened next?

21 DAVID JONES: Then she hit me. I hit her.

22 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: With a stick too?

23 DAVID JONES: Huh-uh.

24 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Oh, she -- you
25 (Untranslatable) the stick?

1 DAVID JONES: Yeah. She swunged again. I
2 ducked. I just came up and grabbed her.
3 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And when you grabbed her,
4 what did you do?
5 DAVID JONES: Kind of hold her.
6 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: From the front or how
7 were you?
8 DAVID JONES: From the back.
9 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: So you got behind her?
10 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
11 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And you put your arm over
12 her shoulders like this?
13 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
14 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And then you put -- so
15 your elbow -- so her neck and her face is facing your
16 elbow?
17 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
18 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: So if she wanted to, she
19 could have bit you and tried to cause more damage?
20 DAVID JONES: Yeah. She was going to.
21 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. And when she --
22 when you had your arm around like this, what was she
23 doing with her arms and her legs?
24 DAVID JONES: Kicking.
25 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Kicking?

1 DAVID JONES: And I kind of had my feet all
2 spreaded out saying, "Come on. Calm down." Okay. I
3 told her -- okay. I gave her the money. She
4 stopped. As soon as she stopped, that's when I ran.
5 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. And you left her
6 there?
7 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
8 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: You didn't put water on
9 her face though?
10 DAVID JONES: No, because I didn't have
11 nothing to put nothing on her face.
12 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. And did she --
13 what did she say? Was she screaming anything at you?
14 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
15 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: (Untranslatable)
16 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) that she passed
17 out.
18 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Oh, then you ran?
19 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
20 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay.
21 DAVID JONES: That's the only chance I had --
22 had a chance, you know, like that.
23 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Did she take you to that
24 place and you followed her?
25 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

1 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: You didn't take her. So
2 She took you?
3 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) night.
4 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yeah.
5 DAVID JONES: You know, right there, I was
6 kind of blaming myself, you know. If I just went
7 straight home --
8 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Uh-huh.
9 DAVID JONES: -- and stuff.
10 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Did you actually fall
11 down and -- when you were trying to get away from the
12 stick and stuff, did you guys actually fall down and
13 roll around on the floor?
14 DAVID JONES: Oh, no. I slipped.
15 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: You slipped. Well, did
16 you already have her in the choke hold?
17 DAVID JONES: Huh-uh. She swung the stick. I
18 kind of slipped myself.
19 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And then you got her, and
20 you put her in the choke hold?
21 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
22 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Did you fall after that?
23 Did you both fall down after that?
24 DAVID JONES: Huh-uh.
25 DETECTIVE MANSKE: You just -- you didn't fall

1 down with her. You just -- you were both standing
2 up?

3 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

4 DETECTIVE MANSKE: When this --

5 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) just lay her
6 down. I just found something in the alley, you know.

7 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: You did find something in
8 the alley?

9 DAVID JONES: And it was kind of dark. It was
10 hard to see. Whatever it was -- it felt like a
11 blanket. You know, I just put my hand right there
12 and looked around, eased on out, walked away. She
13 was okay, and she probably got her clothes on. And
14 after I left, she could have found somebody else.

15 DETECTIVE MANSKE: You know, I need to talk to
16 you about that. Did they (Untranslatable) photo?

17 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Do you want some coffee?

18 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

19 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: What would you like?

20 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Want a soda?

21 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

22 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Coca-Cola?

23 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

24 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay.

25 DAVID JONES: Is it all right if I smoke?

1 DETECTIVE MANSKE: No. We can't let you
2 smoke. I'll get you a soda. Just sit here for a
3 minute.
4 DAVID JONES: When am I going to go back?
5 DETECTIVE MANSKE: In a little bit.
6 DAVID JONES: All right.
7 (Interruption in the proceedings)
8 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Oh, I forgot -- I forgot to
9 get David a Coke.
10 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: I need like 10 more
11 minutes. You only have like 10 more minutes before
12 I --
13 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay.
14 DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: What kind of Coke? Just
15 a regular Coke?
16 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. Can you kind of loosen
17 these?
18 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Sure.
19 DAVID JONES: These things are so tight.
20 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Well, you should have said
21 something.
22 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
23 DETECTIVE MANSKE: How's that? How about the
24 other one?
25 DAVID JONES: The same.

1 DETECTIVE MANSKE: How's that?
2 DAVID JONES: Okay.
3 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. Detective
4 (Untranslatable) was telling me -- do you remember --
5 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
6 DETECTIVE MANSKE: -- this lady?
7 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
8 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Where did you know her
9 from?
10 DAVID JONES: Well, I saw her in the
11 (Untranslatable)
12 DETECTIVE MANSKE: (Untranslatable)
13 DAVID JONES: Yeah, in the (Untranslatable) a
14 couple of times, you know. And I -- like every
15 morning I go through I might see her right there.
16 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah.
17 DAVID JONES: Every time I pop up, she might
18 be there and through one night, you know.
19 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Is she a working girl?
20 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
21 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Did she ever come over
22 there and visit at Taco Bell?
23 DAVID JONES: She doesn't know what Taco Bell
24 I work at.
25 DETECTIVE MANSKE: (Untranslatable)

1 DAVID JONES: She doesn't know which one I
2 work at.

3 DETECTIVE MANSKE: (Untranslatable)

4 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

5 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah.

6 DAVID JONES: I don't know.

7 DETECTIVE MANSKE: No?

8 DAVID JONES: I don't know because some
9 people -- certain people I don't know who he know.

10 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah.

11 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

12 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Did you and her have a --
13 did you get together?

14 DAVID JONES: Just that one time.

15 DETECTIVE MANSKE: And where was that at?

16 DAVID JONES: Over there somewhere like behind
17 some duplexes.

18 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Behind some duplexes?

19 DAVID JONES: That's the last time I remember.

20 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh. What happened --
21 go ahead. Go ahead.

22 DAVID JONES: That's the last time -- I mean,
23 this is the same one -- this is the same one right
24 there in the pink?

25 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah.

1 DAVID JONES: Because last time I seen her she
2 was -- she just don't look the same.

3 DETECTIVE MANSKE: She looks more like this,
4 doesn't she?

5 DAVID JONES: No. She looked like that when I
6 left her like -- like she looks now. She looked like
7 that when I left her.

8 DETECTIVE MANSKE: That's not a very
9 (Untranslatable) picture of her.

10 DAVID JONES: Oh, okay.

11 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Do you recall where was it
12 you were with her last, the last time you two were
13 together?

14 DAVID JONES: In the alley.

15 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. Off which street?
16 Which --

17 DAVID JONES: I don't remember which street.

18 DETECTIVE MANSKE: (Untranslatable)

19 DAVID JONES: I was kind of --

20 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

21 DAVID JONES: -- hitting the bottle a little
22 bit.

23 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah. Smoking the rock.
24 Was she smoking the rock?

25 DAVID JONES: I don't know about earlier. She

1 could have earlier.

2 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh. Did she with you?

3 Did you do any rock that night?

4 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

5 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Did you?

6 DAVID JONES: I had about -- like a big -- you

7 know, a big 50.

8 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Oh, really? Did you spit

9 it with her?

10 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

11 DETECTIVE MANSKE: The whole thing?

12 DAVID JONES: Just half of it.

13 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Oh, just half of it?

14 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

15 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. Where did you get

16 the rock from?

17 DAVID JONES: From a friend of mine.

18 DETECTIVE MANSKE: From a friend of yours?

19 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

20 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Do you know the area where

21 you last saw her?

22 DAVID JONES: Somewhere farther across town.

23 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Oh, okay. How did you meet

24 her that night?

25 DAVID JONES: Oh, that night I got off the bus

1 (Untranslatable) to one of my friends up there at the
2 gas station on Figueroa and Century.
3 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.
4 DAVID JONES: Because that's where you get
5 (Untranslatable)
6 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay.
7 DAVID JONES: I didn't see none of them. I
8 go -- okay. I'm going to walk down the street. I
9 might see somebody I know.
10 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Right.
11 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
12 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Was she down there by that
13 motel on 108th? Is that where you saw her?
14 DAVID JONES: 108th?
15 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yes. You know where
16 (Untranslatable) Burger is there, (Untranslatable)
17 Burger on 101st? It's down in the motel down
18 further.
19 DAVID JONES: Yeah. I know where it's at.
20 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Was the motel where she
21 was -- was she down there when you saw her?
22 DAVID JONES: Because I got off the -- I got
23 off the bus.
24 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. You got off the bus
25 at Century and Fig?

1 DAVID JONES: Yeah. I thought I was going to
2 see somebody. I didn't see nobody.

3 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

4 DAVID JONES: I walked down, and I always do
5 forget about that motel on Broadway. I said, "Well,
6 I'm going to walk down here." (Untranslatable) down
7 here, and that's what happened.

8 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay.

9 DAVID JONES: And I was walking and smoking a
10 cigarette. (Untranslatable) this joint I had --
11 there's this joint I had in my pocket, and I smoked
12 that.

13 I was walking down the street, and I
14 started looking. I thought I was going -- that's
15 when my head started getting blurry a little bit.
16 And I said, "Woe." I said, "It looks like a mean,
17 old woman walking down the street."

18 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

19 DAVID JONES: Okay. That's what happens. If
20 it was a man, I would keep on walking. If it was a
21 woman, I would say something. And the next thing it
22 was woman. I said, "Hey, do you want to get high?"
23 She said, "Yeah." I think she kind of know it was --
24 because I had my uniform on.

25 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

1 DAVID JONES: I said, "I hope this girl don't
2 think I have some money." The only way I know how to
3 do it -- trying to talk my way out of it -- think I
4 don't have no money.

5 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah.

6 DAVID JONES: You know, and I started doing
7 like this, picking my pocket (Untranslatable). So I
8 put the money in my shoe just in case -- just in case
9 she comes down.

10 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah.

11 DAVID JONES: And if she takes my wallet, you
12 don't have nothing in it.

13 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Right.

14 DAVID JONES: And I put like \$100 right here.
15 I put it in my pocket. I put about \$100
16 (Untranslatable)

17 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

18 DAVID JONES: And just in case someone go
19 down, I was -- I told myself, well, I'm just
20 preparing myself --

21 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Sure.

22 DAVID JONES: -- for the worst. I'm walking.
23 I was walking. So (Untranslatable) like this or
24 something.

25 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah.

1 DAVID JONES: So I walk. It's getting dark.
2 It's getting dark now. It started getting dark. So
3 I was prepared. I said, "Okay." I prepared myself
4 for the worst.
5 Then I was right there (Untranslatable).
6 Have you ever heard of it? I was smoking a little
7 bit. She smoked that. I put the rest in my pocket.
8 Then after that, she (Untranslatable) like that and
9 snapped. I told her I felt this was coming.
10 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah.
11 DAVID JONES: I kind of felt this was coming.
12 Okay. I felt it. And if I would have just turned
13 and went down the street down 101st --
14 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah.
15 DAVID JONES: -- I would have just avoided all
16 of this.
17 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.
18 DAVID JONES: Avoid it.
19 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. What started
20 (Untranslatable) between you and her? Did she take a
21 (Untranslatable) at you?
22 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
23 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Oh, is that right?
24 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. She got -- she got --
25 tip me across the head a little bit.

1 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Oh, no shit.

2 DAVID JONES: I mean, I ducked just in time.

3 I was kind of -- she would have got the top of my

4 head, you know.

5 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

6 DAVID JONES: And that's why I was slipping

7 down at the same time.

8 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah.

9 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable). And she turns

10 all the way around. She was going to swing again.

11 That's how I got a chance to grab her real quick.

12 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

13 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable). Okay, okay,

14 okay (Untranslatable). I said, "Okay."

15 (Untranslatable) turned around. See, that's the only

16 time I had a chance to run.

17 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. Did you hit her with

18 your strong arm again?

19 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

20 DETECTIVE MANSKE: With your right arm?

21 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

22 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay.

23 DAVID JONES: I did like that. I had a chance

24 to run. She was going to (Untranslatable) me.

25 DETECTIVE MANSKE: What -- this was -- where

1 were you at when she started taking a swing at you?
2 There in the alley?
3 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
4 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. And did you guys
5 have sex before she did that?
6 DAVID JONES: No. We didn't have no sex.
7 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Not at all, huh?
8 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
9 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Just smoking a pipe, huh?
10 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
11 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. (Untranslatable).
12 When you laid her down there -- after you had her,
13 you put her down and --
14 DAVID JONES: I kind of slapped her face a
15 little bit, you know.
16 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah.
17 DAVID JONES: She was still alive. She
18 started coming to.
19 DETECTIVE MANSKE: She had dirt all over her
20 and --
21 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
22 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah.
23 DAVID JONES: I say, "Damn." (Untranslatable)
24 she's okay. And after I left her -- I don't know
25 what happened after I left her.

1 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah. After you left her,
2 yeah, you don't know.

3 DAVID JONES: I don't know because she could
4 have did it to the next guy.

5 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Sure.

6 DAVID JONES: Like if she did it to the next
7 guy, this guy could have been 10 times
8 (Untranslatable) I was.

9 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Oh, hell, yeah. Okay.
10 Now, but that's the same girl, huh?

11 DAVID JONES: Yeah.

12 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay.

13 DAVID JONES: Because this guy could have did
14 anything to her.

15 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Oh, sure.

16 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

17 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Absolutely.

18 DAVID JONES: Like this.

19 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay.

20 DAVID JONES: I can't do that to no -- another
21 human being.

22 DETECTIVE MANSKE: David, you told me that you
23 got something out of the alley, the blanket or
24 something out of the alley.

25 DAVID JONES: Oh, yeah, the blanket. I kind

1 of put it down and put her head on top of it like
2 that.

3 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Let her rest?

4 DAVID JONES: Yeah. As long as she was still
5 breathing --

6 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.

7 DAVID JONES: -- that's the part I was happy
8 for.

9 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Oh, yeah.

10 DAVID JONES: You know, as long as she was
11 still alive and stuff. And after I left, I said,
12 "Man, that girl --" I was saying to myself down the
13 street, "That girl is messing with the wrong person."
14 (Untranslatable)

15 DETECTIVE MANSKE: (Untranslatable)

16 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) bumping her
17 off.

18 DETECTIVE MANSKE: No sex though with her?

19 DAVID JONES: Huh-uh. Just the same thing
20 about --

21 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah. Okay. You got a
22 head job from her?

23 DAVID JONES: Yeah. That's all.

24 DETECTIVE MANSKE: That's all?

25 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh, because I had my own --

1 I had my own pipe, and she had hers --
2 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.
3 DAVID JONES: -- and stuff like that.
4 DETECTIVE MANSKE: And she just took all her
5 clothes off so that --
6 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
7 DETECTIVE MANSKE: -- for that \$100?
8 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. See, I get a chance
9 when she was doing that -- I was taking off -- I was
10 pulling off mine. And that's when (Untranslatable) I
11 had a chance to leave.
12 DETECTIVE MANSKE: You said you scraped her
13 across the head?
14 DAVID JONES: Yeah.
15 DETECTIVE MANSKE: What was that -- what was
16 that with?
17 DAVID JONES: Like a -- like a stick. Some
18 kind of type of stick.
19 (End of Side A of Tape No. 141454)
20 DETECTIVE MANSKE: (Untranslatable)
21 DAVID JONES: I said, "Forget that." After
22 that incident --
23 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Uh-huh.
24 DAVID JONES: -- I said, "Forget that."
25 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Yeah. Leave her alone.

1 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) get my money
2 that I was saving and put it in the bank.
3 DETECTIVE MANSKE: Okay. Excuse me.
4 (Untranslatable)
