David, remember we met you yesterday.

I'm Detective Miller.

DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

DETECTIVE MILLER: Detective Harper. And we talked to you yesterday over at the county jail.

DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. What we'd like to do, as we explained to you yesterday, is go back over some of this and that we talked about yesterday, you know, and then (Untranslatable) if I can find the -- remember yesterday we read you those two -- about the two forms that you signed?

DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.

DETECTIVE MILLER: If -- if I can find one now (Untranslatable)

UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Miller?

DETECTIVE MILLER: Yes.

UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: You have phone call,

8	DETECTIVE MILLER: January 27th, 1993. What
9	time you got, Jim?
10	DETECTIVE HARPER: 10:30.
11	DETECTIVE MILLER: 10:30. We're at Parker
12	Center. 3-21-A, okay.
13	David, your name is David Jones?
14	DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
15	DETECTIVE MILLER: What's the number on
16	your booking number; can you see it?
17	DAVID JONES: 336256 (Untranslatable) 37.
18	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Okay. That's it.
19	We talked to you yesterday. We want to
20	review a couple of things.
21	First, these are those two forms that we
22	read to you yesterday and you signed?
23	DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
24	DETECTIVE MILLER: One is I'll read the
25	first one again.

It says, "I, David Jones," and then your 1 initials after that, "do hereby give the below listed 2 3. detectives permission to transport me to a medical facility and have hair, blood, and saliva samples taken from me. 5 I give this permission freely and voluntarily. This detectives did not coerce, 7 threaten, or offer me any special consideration for 8 my cooperation." 9 And then those are your initials again. 10 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. 11 DETECTIVE MILLER: Do you remember --12 13 DAVID JONES: Yeah. 14 DETECTIVE MILLER: -- us reading that to you? 15 DAVID JONES: Yeah. 16 DETECTIVE MILLER: And then you signing that? 17 DAVID JONES: Yeah. 18 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Here, and the other one says, "I, David Jones," and then your initials. 19 20 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. DETECTIVE MILLER: -- "give permission to the 21 22 below listed detectives to remove me from the custody 23 of the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department. 24 The purpose of this -- the purpose of

the detectives for removing me is so that I can

1	direct them to the location where I murdered that
2	woman.
3	This consent is given to by me
4	freely, voluntarily, and without any threats or
5	permission."
6	And that's your initials after that?
7	DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
8	DETECTIVE MILLER: Do you remember us reading

12	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. And that's your
13	signature there, David?
14	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
15	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Okay.
16	DAVID JONES: Only thing about it
17	(Untranslatable)
18	DETECTIVE MILLER: Well, we're going to get
19	around to all that in a second.
2 0	DAVID JONES: Oh.
21	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Remember yesterday
22	we read you your rights. I'm going to do that again.
23	Constitutional rights. That's, you know, cops, we
24	got to go through this stuff.
25	DAVID JONES: Oh, yeah.

DETECTIVE MILLER: And we make sure your --1 2 your rights are protected. You know that. DAVID JONES: Yeah. 3 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So I'll do this, 4 read you your rights again, David. In fact I'll read 5 this form here to you. 6 It says, "I have been advised of my 7 constitutional rights as follows. I have the right 8 to remain silent. 9 I have the right to an attorney of my 10 choice to be present at all stages of the 11 proceedings, including any interviews or questioning 12 by policemen. 13 I also have a right to have my lawyer 14 present during any show-ups held in connection with 15 this or any other crime or crimes. 16 If I cannot afford a lawyer, one will be 17 18 appointed to represent me, free of charge, before questioning. 19 Also, that anything I say or do can be 20 used against me in any subsequent criminal 21 proceedings. 22 I have read and understood. You have 23 read to me and I understand the above listed rights." 24

Okay. I'm going to cross out where it,

"I have read -- I have read this to you." 1 2 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh (Untranslatable) discuss 3 the programs and stuff? DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, as I said, I -- let's 5 see here. Mark that out. "You have read to me and I 6 understand the above listed rights" You understand 7 all these rights that I read to you, David? Is that a yes? 8 9 DAVID JONES: Yes. 10 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. "I do wish to waive 11 my rights as listed above." You want to talk to us 12 about these incidents and cooperate with us? 13 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) 14 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. What I need you to 15 do is initial right there where I scratched that out. 16 I put a little X there by number five. 17 DAVID JONES: Right here? 18 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, that's fine, David, 19 okay. 20 Now, do the same thing here where I scratched this out. I put an X there. And put your 21 22 initials, okay. 23 Now, I need you to sign it right there, 24 David, where it says signature, okay. 25 And put today's date, January -- 1-27 --

DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
DETECTIVE MILLER: 93. And put a time
right next to it. It's 10:36.
DETECTIVE HARPER: A.M.
DETECTIVE MILLER: A.M., okay. And I'll sign
as a witness, okay. Put that away, okay.
What we're going to do is go back over
what you explained to us yesterday about how you knew
these girls and where you met them, you know, just so
that we understand it better.
DAVID JONES: Sometime I speak to them. I say
hi to them, you know, because I barely see with
me, I barely come around the neighborhood too much
because a lot of happenings go around there, you
know, like shooting.
DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. You
DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
DETECTIVE MILLER: Where abouts do you live?
DAVID JONES: Huh?
DETECTIVE MILLER: Where do you live at?
DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) San Gabriel.
DETECTIVE MILLER: And the address there?
DAVID JONES: 234 East 101.
DETECTIVE MILLER: 234 East 101, okay. How
far is that from the that school where you went,

1	the elementary school? Is it 97th Street School?
2	DAVID JONES: From my house to there?
3	DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.
4	DAVID JONES: Like five 10 minutes.
5	DETECTIVE MILLER: Five or 10 minutes?
6	DAVID JONES: By foot.
7	DETECTIVE MILLER: By foot?
8	DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
9	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Did you go to
10	elementary school there?
11	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
12	DETECTIVE MILLER: Oh, so you're quite with
13	it.
14	DAVID JONES: I was a kid in the neighborhood.
15	DETECTIVE MILLER: Right.
16	DAVID JONES: The whole neighborhood.
17	DETECTIVE MILLER: Well, you go over there and
18	play ball and everything else?
19	DAVID JONES: Right, I used to go over and
20	play ball during the daytime.
21	DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.
22	DAVID JONES: Like every now and then all the
23	guys get together sometimes like sometimes at school.
24	DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.

DAVID JONES: And sometime on the weekend.

1	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So you've lived in
2	the neighborhood for how long?
3	DAVID JONES: Last when I lived in the
4	neighborhood (Untranslatable) like that.
5	DETECTIVE MILLER: So you lived there for a
6	long, long time.
7	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) and we moved
8	from there (Untranslatable) my mother had moved from
9	there when I was in jail (Untranslatable) time.
10	DETECTIVE MILLER: Right.
11	DAVID JONES: I was younger.
12	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
13	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
14	DETECTIVE MILLER: So you've lived there most
15	of your adult life, most of your life.
16	DAVID JONES: Well, most of my young life.
17	DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.
18	DAVID JONES: Okay. And I got out when I was
19	18.
20	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
21	DAVID JONES: And during the years and stuff,
22	you know.
23	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
24	DAVID JONES: I started hanging around
25	(Untranslatable) that's (Untranslatable)

1	DETECTIVE MILLER: Pictures (Untranslatable)
2	DETECTIVE HARPER: (Untranslatable)
3	DETECTIVE MILLER: No, the no, the
4	DETECTIVE HARPER: The workbook?
5	DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, the workbook. I
6	think it's on my desk (Untranslatable)
7	DAVID JONES: And see, like something like the
8	guys do, you know, like some will go down with them,
9	you know, blame me for something.
10	DETECTIVE MILLER: (Untranslatable)
11	DAVID JONES: And something like that.
12	DETECTIVE MILLER: Well, what we're going to
13	do is just go back and, you know, we can compare what
14	happened
15	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
16	DETECTIVE MILLER: (Untranslatable) don't
17	involved you.
18	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
19	DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, just (Untranslatable)
20	you know.
21	DAVID JONES: Because if I didn't do it
22	DETECTIVE MILLER: That's I told you
23	yesterday we're trying to eliminate you.
24	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) yeah.
25	DETECTIVE MILLER: Just the same as we try

1	and, you know, make somebody the suspect, we also
2	have the duty of trying to eliminate them as a
3	suspect.
4	DAVID JONES: Oh.
5	DETECTIVE MILLER: Right?
6	DAVID JONES: Oh, okay (Untranslatable) I
7	don't I don't hurt nobody, you know, because if I
8	get high I might flake out (Untranslatable)
9	DETECTIVE MILLER: Sure.
10	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
11	DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.
12	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) I might I
13	might talk stuff, you know, because somebody
14	(Untranslatable) beat me up, I be (Untranslatable)
15	because a lot of times my brother see me like that.
16	DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.
17	DAVID JONES: You know, they (Untranslatable)
18	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay (Untranslatable)
19	yesterday we showed you this picture and you said you
20	remembered this girl. Remember
21	DAVID JONES: Oh, yeah, because a lot of times
22	my brother talks to her. I I
23	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. You you know what
24	her name was?

DAVID JONES: Huh-uh, I never knew her.

1	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. But you but
2	you you've seen her.
3	DAVID JONES: I've seen her around.
4	DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, okay.
5	DAVID JONES: Because my brother my brother
6	had known her real well.
7	DETECTIVE MILLER: That's , okay.
8	Remember yesterday you told us that you dated her,
9	took her over to the school. You guys smoked dope,
10	crack.
11	DAVID JONES: Yeah, that's it.
12	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. What okay. Well,
13	yeah, I know, David. Where'd you meet her at that
14	night?
15	DAVID JONES: Uh.
16	DETECTIVE MILLER: Do you remember when it
17	was?
18	DAVID JONES: I was kind of
19	DETECTIVE MILLER: How long ago?
20	DAVID JONES: That was because I was toasted,
21	you know
22	DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.
23	DAVID JONES: myself.
24	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Toasted. You mean
25	you were have drinks, a little coke?

1	DAVID JONES: No, I was drinking most
2	mostly.
3	DETECTIVE MILLER: Mostly drinking?
4	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
5	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
6	DAVID JONES: Like a lot of times whenever I
7	drink I just (Untranslatable) get me some, you know.
8	DETECTIVE MILLER: Getting some.
9	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
10	DETECTIVE MILLER: Oh, a woman?
11	DAVID JONES: No, the coke.
12	DETECTIVE MILLER: Coke?
13	DAVID JONES: Yeah, something
14	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
15	DAVID JONES: And
16	DETECTIVE MILLER: This this girl here,
17	, where did you meet her at that night?
18	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
19	DETECTIVE MILLER: Recall?
20	DAVID JONES: I think, yeah, but I know I was
21	walking.
22	DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.
23	DAVID JONES: And (Untranslatable)
24	DETECTIVE MILLER: Well, was it near the
25	school there? Or

1	DAVID JONES: Yeah (Untranslatable)
2	DETECTIVE MILLER: On Fig or on Broadway or
3	what?
4	DAVID JONES: Probably on Fig.
5	DETECTIVE MILLER: Fig?
6	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
7	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Fig and what street
8	roughly?
9	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) 99th, 98, or
10	97.
11	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Between 97th and
12	99th?
13	DAVID JONES: Something like that.
14	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. And what kind of
15	discussion did you guys have, you know, go over and
16	smoke a little coke or get a little have a little
17	sex? Or what was the offer?
18	DAVID JONES: Yeah, you know, like that, yeah.
19	DETECTIVE MILLER: Well, what was, you know,
20	tell me (Untranslatable)
21	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) I'd say okay.
22	We did that, you know, and that was it. Then I left.
23	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. When
24	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
25	DETECTIVE MILLER: When did she approach

1	you or did you approach her on the street? Did she
2	walk up to you and ask you for a date or, you know,
3	did you ask tell you you approached her?
4	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
5	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. What did you
6	DAVID JONES: And I asked her I asked her
7	what's up for the night, you know.
8	DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.
9	DAVID JONES: She said, "Not too much." I
10	said, "I got a little little money, you know, got
11	a little thing (Untranslatable) and she said, "Well,
12	what do you want to do." I said, "I don't got enough
13	for a motel." She said, "Well, let's go
14	(Untranslatable) like that.
15	DETECTIVE MILLER: Smoke you mean?
16	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
17	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So you agreed on
18	going to get it over at the school.
19	DAVID JONES: And that's it.
20	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. You walked how'd
21	you get there?
22	DAVID JONES: You got to walk around like
23	(Untranslatable)
24	DETECTIVE MILLER: Down the alley or
25	DAVID JONES: No, over there where the

1	where the cars at between that shop and the corner of
2	that street.
3	DETECTIVE MILLER: Oh, the street there at
4	97th where it dead ends there?
5	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
6	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Then they got the
7	big gate into the school?
8	DAVID JONES: Yeah, then they got that
9	(Untranslatable)
10	DETECTIVE MILLER: Is it a little small gate?
11	DAVID JONES: Yeah, yeah.
12	DETECTIVE MILLER: See, the big gate they
13	drive the cars in.
14	DAVID JONES: Yeah, sometimes the big
15	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
16	DAVID JONES: Sometimes both of them be open.
17	DETECTIVE MILLER: Right.
18	DAVID JONES: Sometime.
19	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So you and her walk
20	down
21	DAVID JONES: Walking toward the bleachers.
22	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
23	DAVID JONES: And because that's where I
24	wanted just in case somebody do come, I'd be like
25	in the open and see.

1	DETECTIVE MILLER: And that's right by the
2	bungalows?
3	DAVID JONES: Yeah, no, by the bleachers where
4	you eat your lunch.
5	DETECTIVE MILLER: Oh, okay.
6	DAVID JONES: Because like you'll see anybody
7	come
8	DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.
9	DAVID JONES: right right there by the
10	cafeteria.
11	DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.
12	DAVID JONES: You know, like something behind
13	you, something in front of you. Or you can walk up a
14	little bit and you look down and see who coming, who
15	coming across
16	DETECTIVE MILLER: So you got a good view from
17	there.
18	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
19	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So what'd you guys
20	do when you got over there?
21	DAVID JONES: We smoke, you know.
22	DETECTIVE MILLER: What kind of sex did you
23	have?
24	DAVID JONES: We didn't she did some.
25	DETECTIVE MILLER: (Untranslatable) head?

1	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
2	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
3	DAVID JONES: I said I didn't want nothing
4	else.
5	DETECTIVE MILLER: You just wanted some head
6	from her, okay.
7	How much rock do you guys smoke? Did
8	she have her own or do you provide her some or
9	DAVID JONES: I I brought a a 10.
10	DETECTIVE MILLER: A 10?
11	DAVID JONES: Yeah, and that, you know, I gave
12	her half. I kept half.
13	DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.
14	DAVID JONES: Well (Untranslatable) I don't
15	know whatever she had on her own.
16	DETECTIVE MILLER: Right, but just while she's
17	with you.
18	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
19	DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah.
20	DAVID JONES: You know, because I
21	(Untranslatable) the night. And after we did that
22	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. When yesterday
23	you told us that she got a little uppie with you.
24	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
25	DETECTIVE MILLER: And

DAVID JONES: Then I start fighting her back 1 2 and stuff, you know. DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Did she hit you 3 first? 4 5 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Why did she hit you? 6 7 DAVID JONES: I don't know. Probably just 8 flaked out. DETECTIVE MILLER: Just flaked out, huh? 9 10 DAVID JONES: Uh-huh. DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. When she flaked out 11 12 did she hit you a couple of times or what was -- what happened? 13 14 DAVID JONES: No, I -- I duck (Untranslatable) DETECTIVE MILLER: You're ducking her punches? 15 DAVID JONES: Yeah, you know (Untranslatable) 16 get out with those girls (Untranslatable) 17 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. When you grabbed 18 19 her, did you grab her with your left arm or your 20 right arm? DAVID JONES: I just -- I don't know how I 21 22 grabbed her. I just grabbed her, you know. 23 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So you just -what'd you tell us yesterday? Your strong arm? 24

that the -- that's your -- your right arm is your

strong arm? 1 2 DAVID JONES: Yeah, this arm get, you know, sometime it give out. 3 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. So what happened once you grabbed her? 5 DAVID JONES: You know, I grabbed her (Untranslatable) 7 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. You grabbed her. How -- you're showing me, you're using your arm. You 9 grab her --10 DAVID JONES: Yeah, you know, grab by her arm 11 kind of like you do like in wrestling. 12 DETECTIVE MILLER: You got arm around her 13 14 head, neck area like that? DAVID JONES: Uh-huh, then I said, "Be cool. 15 Be cool." Then I did set her down. 16 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. You laid her down? 17 DAVID JONES: I sat her down. 18 19 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah. DAVID JONES: And she was still breathing. 20 And I said, "Well, I'm going to get out of here, you 21 know, because if I do something I might end up 22 hurting this girl, you know, it'd be like assault and 23 24 battery." DETECTIVE MILLER: 25 Right.

DAVID JONES: Then I left. 1 DETECTIVE MILLER: She was laying down when 2 you left. 3 DAVID JONES: Yeah, she was okay. And then I I said, "Well, she come through it." 5 DETECTIVE MILLER: Yeah, when she comes to 6 she's going to be all right and you took off. 7 DAVID JONES: Yeah, yeah. 8 DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Do you recall 9 which -- was your right, left arm that you put her 10 11 down with? 12 DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) DETECTIVE MILLER: Show you the photo. Maybe 13 that will help you. I'm going to show you the photo 14 of the of the area, okay. I'm going to show you a 15 16 picture that's got number 19 on it, little circle and 17 19, okay. That's -- is that where you left her? DAVID JONES: Huh-uh. 18 DETECTIVE MILLER: No? 19 DAVID JONES: No, to the right. This the 20 bungalow, see. If like you go -- let me see, that's 21 the front. That's the -- that's the front thing. 22 23 Like you go right like towards the freeway. 24 DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.

DAVID JONES: On Flower.

1	DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.
2	DAVID JONES: That's where we was at.
3	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
4	DAVID JONES: And after that I don't know
5	what happened after that.
6	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. But when you put her
7	down, she laid there and you just walked off.
8	DAVID JONES: Yeah, she was she was cool.
9	When I left she was cool.
10	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
11	DAVID JONES: You know, she was still
12	breathing and stuff, everything else. Because I know
13	I didn't squeeze choke squeeze (Untranslatable)
14	DETECTIVE MILLER: You didn't choke her that
15	hard.
16	DAVID JONES: No.
17	DETECTIVE MILLER: (Untranslatable)
18	DAVID JONES: And I did. And (Untranslatable)
19	I said, "I know you I know you being high and
20	stuff." And I said, "Girl, just rest." See, because
21	she kind of still looking, you know, her eyes like
22	like this.
23	DETECTIVE MILLER: Uh-huh.
24	DAVID JONES: I said, "Girl (Untranslatable)
25	let me walk out. I'm going to leave."

1	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. That's when you had
2	the choke on her?
3	DAVID JONES: Yeah, that's what I just told
4	her I said, "Be cool."
5	DETECTIVE MILLER: Your right arm, okay.
6	You're showing with your right arm like that.
7	DAVID JONES: Like this. I said, "Be cool.
8	I'm going to let you go. Please don't hit me."
9	DETECTIVE MILLER: Then you just let her fall
10	down? You
11	DAVID JONES: No.
12	DETECTIVE MILLER: You laid her down?
13	DAVID JONES: Yeah, she she said, "Okay."
14	I put her down. She still was talking. And I just
15	left.
16	DETECTIVE MILLER: And she was laying down and
17	you just walked off.
18	DAVID JONES: Yeah, she was
19	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay.
20	DAVID JONES: I told her I said, "Be cool,
21	you know."
22	DETECTIVE MILLER: Okay. Jim, you got any
23	DETECTIVE HARPER: Where where did you
24	where did you learn how to choke? You you said
25	you had a like a what do you call that? The kind

1	of hold that you had her in? Well, what do do you
2	know what you call that or you just grab her around
3	the neck with your right arm?
4	DAVID JONES: I know I know like like
5	like on TV.
6	DETECTIVE HARPER: Like on TV?
7	DAVID JONES: TV, yeah, yeah.
8	DETECTIVE HARPER: Who who did you see
9	who did you see use it on TV?
10	DAVID JONES: Cops on TV. Cops

13	Go ahead (Untranslatable). You know, I know did
14	you work different hours at Taco Bell?
15	DAVID JONES: Just in the morning.
16	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Just in the morning?
17	DAVID JONES: Yeah, at Taco Bell like 7:00 to
18	11:00.
19	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: 7:00 in the morning until
20	11:00 in the morning?
21	DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
22	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And then you have the
23	rest of the day and the night (Untranslatable)
24	DAVID JONES: Yeah. That's why I go in the

middle -- I go home in the middle. Then I have to go

1	over to the Goodwill.
2	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Oh, because you have two
3	jobs?
4	DAVID JONES: See, the Goodwill, when I got me
5	that job
6	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Right.
7	DAVID JONES: you know, because I was still
8	employed with them
9	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Right.
10	DAVID JONES: working with Taco Bell.
11	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: So you go over to the
12	Goodwill in the afternoon. What time do you get off
13	at the Goodwill when you go?
14	DAVID JONES: 3:00, 3:15
15	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: P.M.? In the afternoon
16	or in the morning?
17	DAVID JONES: In the afternoon.
18	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. You know, I know a
19	lot of times when the girls see that you have a job
20	and you're in your Taco Bell outfit and stuff, they
21	know you have money or they think you have money. So
22	they they come on to you, right?
23	DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
24	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Because they think, well,

I'll get some quick money from you.

1	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
2	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Isn't that pretty much
3	what they think?
4	DAVID JONES: Because if I do it like
5	(Untranslatable) just wear my street clothes, they
6	don't know I got no money.
7	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yeah.
8	DAVID JONES: See, if I (Untranslatable)
9	before
10	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: They wouldn't have
11	bothered you?
12	DAVID JONES: Yeah. They'd thought I was just
13	a regular guy.
14	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yeah. And all the
15	times all the girls that you have come in contact
16	with so far, they have all come up to you or have you
17	gone up to some of them?
18	DAVID JONES: I think every now and then
19	sometimes sometimes they do walk away from me.
20	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. But most of the
21	time, they come up to you, right?
22	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
23	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. And they probably
24	wouldn't be in the situation if they wouldn't come up
25	to you, right, to begin with?

DAVID JONES: Yeah.

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: I mean, they wouldn't have been in a situation where, you know, something happened later on where they got a little rough with you?

DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) sometimes ___
DETECTIVE MANSKE: Excuse me. I'll be right
back.

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Sometimes what?

DAVID JONES: Well, sometimes I'm a nice guy. I try to be nice, you know (Untranslatable) a woman. Some of them -- some of them just take advantage of them.

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Some women do take advantage. .

DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Well, there is just one person who was like that, a girl. She was like that. She was -- you know, she didn't have a problem with walking up to guys, and sometimes she took advantage of some of them. And that's who I'm pretty much concerned about.

22	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
23	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Or down by
24	DAVID JONES: Like you (Untranslatable)
25	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Uh-huh.

1	DAVID JONES: On (Untranslatable) Street.
2	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. How do you get
3	there?
4	DAVID JONES: I think it was take Broadway.
5	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: (Untranslatable). I'm
6	sorry. (Untranslatable). How do you get there as
7	far as a ride? Do you have a car?
8	DAVID JONES: By bus.
9	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: All the time by bus or do
10	sometimes family members take you?
11	DAVID JONES: No. I always go by bus.
12	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: You always go by bus.
13	Okay. Now, this one girl, her name was
14	you know any girl named Can you remember
15	(Untranslatable)?
16	She's a little short girl, and she had
17	like a little black Afro. And she was wearing a red
18	top and some white pants. Do you remember that? You
19	don't remember that?
20	DAVID JONES: No. I don't remember her
21	because I know most everybody in the neighborhood.
22	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Uh-huh. She's real cute.
23	DAVID JONES: I kind of most know everybody in
24	the neighborhood around there.

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Hold on a minute. Let me

1	see if I have a good picture of her. I know I do.
2	(Interruption in the proceedings)
3	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) because when I
4	leave from Goodwill
5	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Uh-huh.
6	DAVID JONES: I get home around night.
7	DETECTIVE MANSKE: You go all over though,
8	right? You have been all over South L.A., over on
9	Florence (Untranslatable)
10	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Imperial Highway.
11	DAVID JONES: I don't go over there. I don't
12	go back there.
13	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: How long have you lived
14	in L.A.?
15	DAVID JONES: A long time.
16	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: So you know the ins and
17	outs of L.A. You know the freeways and
18	(Untranslatable), and that's okay.
19	DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)
20	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Yeah. I mean, this isn't
21	a trick question. I'm not trying to trick you.
22	DAVID JONES: Like sometimes, you know, I
23	go like I go (Untranslatable). I go like the Blue
24	Line, hop on the Blue Line.
25	DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Oh, okay.

DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable)

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. I know which one she is. Okay. See this girl in the pink. Do you remember her? In the pink dress, not the one (Untranslatable) girl on the left.

DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) little boy?

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: With the little boy,

yeah. She's wearing that pink dress.

DETECTIVE MANSKE: She looks -- she looks nice and innocent in that picture, but she fights all the time with people, all the time.

DAVID JONES: (Untranslatable) in my neighborhood so far. (Untranslatable) you know, if I didn't pay no attention because I see a lot of -- a lot of people be over there.

DETECTIVE MANSKE: Well, she is in your neighborhood. She lives in your neighborhood.

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: And see, the same thing kind of happened to her that happened to a couple of the other girls that --

DAVID JONES: Well --

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Like the ones at the school and stuff, you know. And so that's why I know you probably know her. You probably just don't recognize her face.

And she probably fought because she was a fighter. She was real feisty, but she liked to have sex. And so I just need to know what happened. You know, like you said, most of the time it was self-defense, and that's fine.

DAVID JONES: I didn't say that. She got killed on Imperial?

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: No. I didn't say that.

DAVID JONES: Oh, all right.

DETECTIVE CANCHOLA: Okay. That's where she was (Untranslatable). That's where she (Untranslatable). You can find her at Imperial or Century or Vermont or Hoover or Figueroa. That's where she was always around.

DAVID JONES: If I did, I don't know.

6	DAVID JONES: Uh-huh.
7	DETECTIVE MANSKE: Did they ever bite you or
8	anything like that?
9	DAVID JONES: Because I was (Untranslatable)
10	with my hand back and stuff.
11	DETECTIVE MANSKE: What do you mean with your
12	hand back?

14	(Untranslatable) bite me or something
15	(Untranslatable)

3	home with mine. I go in the house and smoke.
4	DETECTIVE MANSKE: When these girls would
5	fight fight you fight with you, and the more
6	they fought, the more you would have to hit them or
7	choke them or
8	DAVID JONES: Yeah.
9	DETECTIVE MANSKE: What do you call it? What
10	do you call that? Just a choke hold?
11	DAVID JONES: No. (Untranslatable) like right
12	here. In other words, I was kind of slowing down.
