3 A Yes, he did.

4 Q And what, if anything, did he say to you?

5 A He described exactly how the female jogger was  
6 attacked, who hit her.

7 MR. JOSEPH: Objection.

8 THE COURT: I'll allow it.

9 A How he kicked her. How her clothes were ripped  
10 off and how different individuals, including himself being  
11 number three, jumped on top, followed by two other indivi-

13 Q How long did Antron McCray speak when he descri-

17 Q When he described what he and others had done

21 yes, and then I asked him if he had come and he said no.

22 Q Did Mr. McCray say anything to Antron McCray  
23 during that time?

24 A No.

25 Q After Antron finished describing to you what
