We are here to take the statement of Calvin Ollins concerning the investigation of the fatal beating and sexual assault of i, which occurred on October 18, 1986, at approximately 1:10 a.m., at 1500 West 15th Place, Chicago, Cook County, Illinois.

Calvin, I talked to you earlier and explained that I am an assistant state's attorney, a lawyer working with the police and not your lawyer; is that correct?

MR. OLLINS: Yes.

- Q And before we spoke, I advised you of your constitutional rights; is that correct?
 - A Yeah.
- Q I am going to read you your rights again.

 Do you understand that you have a right to remain silent?
 - A Yes.
 - Q Do you understand that anything you say can be used against you in a court of law?
 - A Yeah.
 - Q Do you understand you have the right to talk to a lawyer and have him present with you while you are being question?
 - A Yes.
 - Q Do you understand if you cannot afford to hire a lawyer one will be appointed by the court to represent you before any questioning, if you wish one?

- Q Do you understand that even though you are a juvenile there can be a hearing at Juvenile Court after which the judge could order you to be tried and sentenced as an adult?
 - A Yes.
- Q Understanding these rights, do you wish to talk to us now?
 - A Yes.

 - A Fourteen.
 - Q When were you born?
 - A June 21st, 1972.
 - Q Do you go to school?
 - A Yeah.

 - Q What is Larry's last name?

- Q Now, while you were out on the street with Larry, Marcellius and Danny, what did you see?

- Q I am going to show you what I have marked as People's Exhibit No. 2 for identification. Do you recognize that?
 - A That's like the stick we had beat the lady with.
 - O Is that similar to that stick?
 - A Yeah.
- Q Now, Calvin, since you have been at the police station, have you been treated well by the police?
 - A Yes.
- Q And you have been treated well by the assistant state's attorney, that is me; is that correct?
 - A Yes.
- Q And you have been given food and coffee and water to drink; is that correct?
 - A Yes.
- Q And you have been allowed to use the bathroom; is that correct?
 - A Yeah.
- Q And nobody's made any promises to you or threats to you in order for you to give this statement; is that correct?
 - A Yeah.
- Q And you are giving this statement because it is the truth about what happened; is that correct?
 - A Yeah.
