MS. SUSSMAN: Let the record reflect that we are in an
interview room at Area 4 Violent Crimes. Today's date is
January 28, 1987. The time is 7:50 a.m. Present in the room
with me, assistant state's attorney Susan Sussman, are

the court reporter and Calvin Ollins.

We are here to take the statement of Calvin Ollins concerning the investigation of the fatal beating and sexual assault of [REDACTED] i, which occurred on October 18, 1986, at approximately 1:10 a.m., at 1500 West 15th Place, Chicago, Cook County, Illinois.

Calvin, I talked to you earlier and explained that I am an assistant state's attorney, a lawyer working with the police and not your lawyer; is that correct?

MR. OLLINS: Yes.

Q And before we spoke, I advised you of your constitutional rights; is that correct?

A Yeah.

Q I am going to read you your rights again.

Do you understand that you have a right to remain silent?

A Yes.

Q Do you understand that anything you say can be used against you in a court of law?

A Yeah.

Q Do you understand you have the right to talk to a lawyer and have him present with you while you are being questioned?

A Yes.

Q Do you understand if you cannot afford to hire a lawyer one will be appointed by the court to represent you before any questioning, if you wish one?

A Yes.

Q Do you understand that even though you are a juvenile there can be a hearing at Juvenile Court after which the judge could order you to be tried and sentenced as an adult?

A Yes.

Q Understanding these rights, do you wish to talk to us now?

A Yes.

Q Calvin, how old are you?

A Fourteen.

Q When were you born?

A June 21st, 1972.

Q Do you go to school?

A Yeah.

Q What school do you go to?

A Carpenter.

Q And what grade are you in at Carpenter School?

A Eighth.

Q Now Calvin, I am going to call your attention to October 18, 1986, in the early morning hours, were you with Larry, Marcellius and Danny, in the area of Loomis and Flournoy in Chicago?


A Yeah.

Q And were you out on the street with those individuals?

A Yes.

Q What is Larry's last name?

A Ollins.

Q And how do you know Larry?

A He is my cousin.

Q And do you know Marcellius' last name?

A No.

Q Do you know Marcellius to be Marcellius Bradford?

A No.

Q Now, while you were out on the street with Larry, Marcellius and Danny, what did you see?

A A car.

Q And was this a four-door car?

A Yes.

Q And what did you see the car do?

A Stop.

Q And what did the car stop for?

A Stop sign.

Q And was that at approximately Loomis and Flournoy?

A Yes.

Q And who was in the car?

A A lady.

Q Was anyone else in the car with the lady?

A No.

Q What did you do when you saw the lady stopped at the stop sign?

A We jumped in the car and I grabbed her from behind.

Q What part of the car did you get into?

A Driver's side.

Q What part of the car did Larry get into?

A The front driver's side. *and he unlocked the*

Q What part of the car did Marcellius get into? *Doors.*

A The front passenger side.

Q What part of the car did Daniel get into?

A The back of the car.

Q Who got in first?

A Larry.

Q What did Larry do when he got in the car?

A He grabbed the lady and Marcellius grabbed the steering wheel and stopped the car. C

Q And when Marcellius grabbed the steering wheel and you all got in the car, what did you do to the lady?

A Grabbed her from behind.

Q How did you grab her from behind?

A Headlock.

Q And after you grabbed the lady in a headlock, where did you go?

A Up on the tracks.

Q And who drove the car first?

A Larry.

Q And did anyone else drive the car besides Larry?

A Yes.

Q Who drove the car besides Larry?

A Daniel.

Q When you got to the tracks, what did you do?

A Went with Larry?

Q What did Larry do?

A Got out of the car and went to the back and opened up
the trunk.

Q And what did he do after that?

A Took out a box.

Q What did he do with the box?

A Put it on the side of the car.

Q After he put the box on the side of the car, what did
he do?

A Went back for the girl.

Q What did he do with the girl?

A He pulled her pants down and bent her over on the car.

Q What did he do after he pulled her pants down and
bent her over the car?

A Fucked her.

Q And how did he do that?

A How did he do that? He stuck his dick in her ass.

Q After he stuck his penis in her behind, what did he do?

A I asked Larry could I have some and he said no.

Q What happened between you and Larry?

A We had an argument.

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Q While you and Larry were arguing about whether you could have some, what did the girl do?

A Ran.

Q What happened to the girl as she was running?

A She fell.

Q After she fell, what did Larry do?

A Ran after her.

Q What did Larry do? Did he catch up with her?

A Yes.

Q When he caught up with the girl, what did Larry do?

A Brought her back to the car.

Q When he brought her back to the car, what did he do then?

A Layed her on the concrete/. That's when he hit her with a piece of concrete.

Q Where did Larry hit the lady with the piece of concrete?

A On the head.

Q After Larry hit the lady with the concrete on the head, what did he do with the lady?

A Put her in the front seat of the car.

Q After he put her in the front seat of the car, what happened?

A I jumped on top of her. I was getting ready to put it in and he held me back.

Q Who held you back?

A Larry.

Q After Larry pulled you off the lady, what happened?

A Daniel got on top of her to give it to her.

Q While you and Larry were arguing, what did Daniel do to the lady?

A Stick his penis in her butt. *and her PUSSY, C.O.*

Q After Daniel stuck his penis in her butt, what happened?

What happened after Daniel did that?

A After Daniel did that he got off ^{C.O.} of her.

Q After Daniel got off ^{C.O.} of the lady, what happened?

A He put her back on the concrete.

Q Where was the lady put on the concrete?

A Beside the car.

Q Who put the lady on the concrete?

A They did.

Q Who are you talking about?

A The lady got put on the concrete and that's when they started kicking her.

Q Who kicked the lady?

A All of them.

Q Did Daniel kick the lady?

A Yes.

Q Did Marcellius kick the lady?

A Yes.

Q And did Larry kick the lady?

A Yes.

A Yes.

A That's when they broke and ran.
Q Who ran first?
A Marcellius and Daniel.
Q After Marcellius and Daniel ran, what did Larry do
with the lady?

Q That was a couple weeks after you took the keys; is that right?

A Yes, ma'am.

Q Where did you put the keys when you first took them from the car?

A On my key ring.

Q Calvin, I am going to show you what I have marked as People's Exhibit No. 1. Do you recognize the lady in that picture?

A Yes.

Q And who is that lady?

A The lady that we were beating up, that was beaten up by us.

Q Is that the same lady that you grabbed in the car?

A Yes.

Q I am going to show you what I have marked as People's Exhibit No. 2 for identification. Do you recognize that?

A That's like the stick we had beat the lady with.

Q Is that similar to that stick?

A Yeah.

Q Now, Calvin, since you have been at the police station, have you been treated well by the police?

A Yes.

Q And you have been treated well by the assistant state's attorney, that is me; is that correct?

A Yes.

Q And you have been given food and coffee and water to drink; is that correct?

A Yes.

Q And you have been allowed to use the bathroom; is that correct?

A Yeah.

Q And nobody's made any promises to you or threats to you in order for you to give this statement; is that correct?

A Yeah.

Q And you are giving this statement because it is the truth about what happened; is that correct?

A Yeah.
