

2 consider this exhibit, which is Exhibit 126, which
3 is a statement by Kevin Richardson against Kevin
4 Richardson. In other words, a statement made by a
5 defendant outside of court may only be considered
6 as evidence against the defendant who made it.
7 And so you can only consider the contents of this
8 statement as it will be read to you against Kevin
9 Richardson. Keep that in mind while listening to
10 it.

11 One other point. When this exhibit is
12 circulated to you, as it will be shortly, you will
13 notice and the officer has already testified, that
14 there are notations on the bottom of each page,
15 the first and second pages. There's also a
16 notation on the right hand side corner of the back
17 page. They have nothing to do with this exhibit
18 in so far as you are concerned. And so you will
19 not consider those notations in any way. Your
20 considering the substance of this statement.

21 Okay.

22 A. It starts off with Kevin Richardson printed his
23 name "Kevin Richardson" and the date is 4 / 20 / 89.

24 "About 8:00 o'clock last night I was with my
25 friends Al, Sheron, and Lamont. We met some people in

2 Central Park, so we started walking around for a while.
3 Then they saw a taxi cab and started throwing rocks on 110th
4 Street and the drive. At this time there were about thirty
5 people all males. All was the same age. Then they saw this
6 old man on the roadway. So this kid came behind him and
7 clotheslined the man. He fell. Everybody was kicking him
8 in the face. Then Antron took his food away from him and
9 ate it. The last time I saw him he was lying on the floor.
10 They pulled him to the side so he won't get hit by a car.
11 We was walking. Then we saw a male and a female on a bike
12 that was built for two. They tried to pull they shirt but
13 they was too fast and they got away. We continue walking
14 around step by step. So we was waiting for a jogger to
15 come. So he came and everybody was hiding behind the trees
16 waiting. Then We jumped out and ran over there to beat him
17 up. That's when Antron hit him with the pipe three or four
18 times. Then I saw him bleeding. I said stop man. He said
19 alright. And everybody start running to the West drive.
20 Then we saw this lady jogger. She had on gray shorts with
21 black biking pants and a white tank top. She was on the
22 road running from east to west. That's when we spotted her.
23 So we started chasing her down the road. Then we caught
24 her. Antron, Raymond and Steve ripped her blouse off and
25 pushed her down. She tried to get back up and Mike punched

2 her back down. She tried to get back up and he kept
3 punching her. Then she was knocked out. That's when
4 Antron, Raymond, and Steve took her clothes off. Before
5 that happened, when Mike hit her down, I tried to grab her.
6 I got scratched on my face. So I moved back. And everybody
7 started feeling on her. I saw somebody, that's where he put
8 the name Raymond above it, pulling her pants off. I saw
9 somebody holding her arms and legs. Raymond had her arms
10 and Steve had her legs. And Antron had sex with her. Again
11 there's another word above the sentence. Before that's when
12 she was yelling stop and help. She was unconscious when
13 they had had left her on the floor. Before this happened
14 they had dragged her into the bushes. Everybody left. And
15 she was still there. The cops stopped five of us and
16 arrested us and I was the one that didn't rape her.

17 The above statement is true. Kevin Richardson. Mr.
18 Paul L. Richardson father's signature, Angela Cuffee,
19 sister. My name is on the side, Detective John Hartigan,
20 Page 2 of 2. And it's on the side with Detective at the
21 time O'Sullivan's.
