- 1 silent and that anything I say can be used against
- 2 me in a court of law.
- 3 "I understand I have a right to
- 4 talk to a lawyer and have him present with me
- 5 during questioning, and if I cannot afford to hire
- a lawyer, one will be appointed by the Court to
- 7 represent me before any questioning.
- 8 "Understanding these rights, I
- 9 wish to give a statement."
- 10 There's an X there, and then the
- 11 defendant signed his name.
- 12 "After being advised of his
- 13 constitutional rights and stating that he
- 14 understood his rights, Lafonso Rollins stated he
- 15 wished to waive his rights.
- 16 "Lafonso Rollins stated he
- 17 understood Caren Armbrust is an assistant
- 18 state's attorney, a prosecutor, and not his
- 19 attorney.
- 20 "Lafonso Rollins stated he wished
- 21 to give the following statement, which is a
- 22 summary, not word for word.
- "Lafonso Rollins states that he
- 24 is 17 years old. He completed eighth grade at

- 1 Maryville Academy, Dolton Education Center. Lafonso Rollins states he started ninth grade at 2 St. Joseph's on Halsted, but never finished. 3 "Lafonso Rollins states he can 4 read and write English and demonstrated this by 5 6 reading the first few lines of the statement out 7 loud. 8 "Lafonso Rollins states that on 9 January 9, 1993, at 1:00 p.m., he was at the building located at 6360 South Minerva. Lafonso 10 Rollins states he is familiar with this building, 11 12 and it is an old folks home. 13 "Lafonso Rollins states that he while 14 went to the apartment of 15 she was in the hallway opening her apartment 16 door. Lafonso Rollins states that when he grabbed her and threw her to the ground, she passed out. 17 18 Lafonso Rollins states he told 19 not to yell or holler.
- "Lafonso Rollins states that he

 had a knife, and he demanded money from

 Lafonso Rollins states that he got about

 do dollars.
- 24 "Lafonso Rollins states that he

- 1 made take off her clothes, and he opened
- 2 his pants. Lafonso Rollins states that he put
- 3 his penis between legs, and he began
- 4 to grind, and then he nutted. Lafonso Rollins
- 5 states that this means he masturbated and
- 6 ejaculated.
- 7 "Lafonso Rollins states he wiped
- 8 · himself off with a pillow case and then left.
- 9 "Lafonso Rollins states he
- 10 identified by a photo. He
- 11 signed this photo and put, number three, on this
- 12 photo.
- "Lafonso Rollins states he has
- 14 been treated well by the assistant
- 15 state's attorney, Caren Armbrust, and the police.
- 16 Lafonso Rollins states he has eaten pizza and a
- 17 sandwich and has had coffee and cola to drink
- 18 while he has been at the police station. Lafonso
- 19 Rollins states that he has has not been threatened
- 20 in any way, nor has he been made any promises for
- 21 this statement.
- 22 "Lafonso Rollins states he is not
- 23 under the influence of drugs or alcohol now.
- 24 Lafonso Rollins states he can make any changes or

- 1 additions to this statement by asking Caren
- 2 Armbrust to do so now. Lafonso Rollins states
- 3 that he had this statement read to him by
- 4 Detective McGrath."
- 5 And then it's signed.
- 6 BY MS. HIGGINS:
- 7 Q. Thank you, Caren.
- 8 Caren, after you showed the
- 9 statement to the defendant and it was read aloud,
- 10 what did you do?
- 11 A. After we had completed all the signing?
- Q. After you completed the corrections and
- 13 all of that has been done?
- 14 A. I asked him one more time if there were
- any changes or additions that he wanted to make,
- and he said, no. Then I took a photograph of
- 17 him.
- 18 (WHEREUPON, People's Exhibit
- Number 21 was marked for
- 20 identification.)
- 21 BY MS. HIGGINS:
- Q. Caren, I'm showing you what's been marked
- 23 as People's Exhibit Number 21 for identification,
- 24 and I'd ask if you recognize that?
